**1. MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 08, 2005 MEETING**

**Mr. MacDonald, seconded by Mr. Stark, moved the minutes be adopted as presented. CARRIED.**

Chairperson Anhorn advised stakeholder meetings to compete for the location of the Single Site Training Centre in Alberta. The Medicine Hat College, Regional Economic Development, City of Medicine Hat, Medicine Hat Police Service, CFB Suffield and others are working together to submit a proposal for the training centre to be built in the Medicine Hat region.

Alderman Dumanowski advised there have been discussions with Mayer Vallely and Council members. A multi-stakeholder approach must be taken and the City will need to put funds into this in order to have an adequate proposal for the Solicitor General.

D/Chief Earl advised the Solicitor General has indicated there will be financial assistance with the second stage of the proposal.

**2. CRIME STOPPERS WEBSITE**

Cst. Sandy Mahon presented an overview of the Medicine Hat Crimestoppers website. Signs donated by AMA, which will be posted on highway entrances into the City, and throughout the City to give more visibility to Crimestoppers.

**3. CHIEF'S REPORT**

**A) Trends & Statistics (including Bylaw Enforcement)**

Inspector Morton provided an overview of the statistics to the end of September. The Traffic Section participated in the Canadian Association of Chief's Police Operation Impact Program, which resulted in 383 tickets being issued for speeding, seat belt violations and equipment violations.

**B) Policing Survey**
