**3. CHIEF'S REPORT**

**A) Trends & Statistics (including Bylaw Enforcement)**

Inspector McGrogan provided an overview of the trends and statistics. Inspector Morton provided an overview of Bylaw Enforcement statistics.

Mr. Walsh voiced concern over the limited number of charges vs warnings being issued for Bylaw infractions. Discussed various reasons and concluded it is about compliance to Bylaws and not the number of charges. Intervention and resolution methods are used prior to charges. 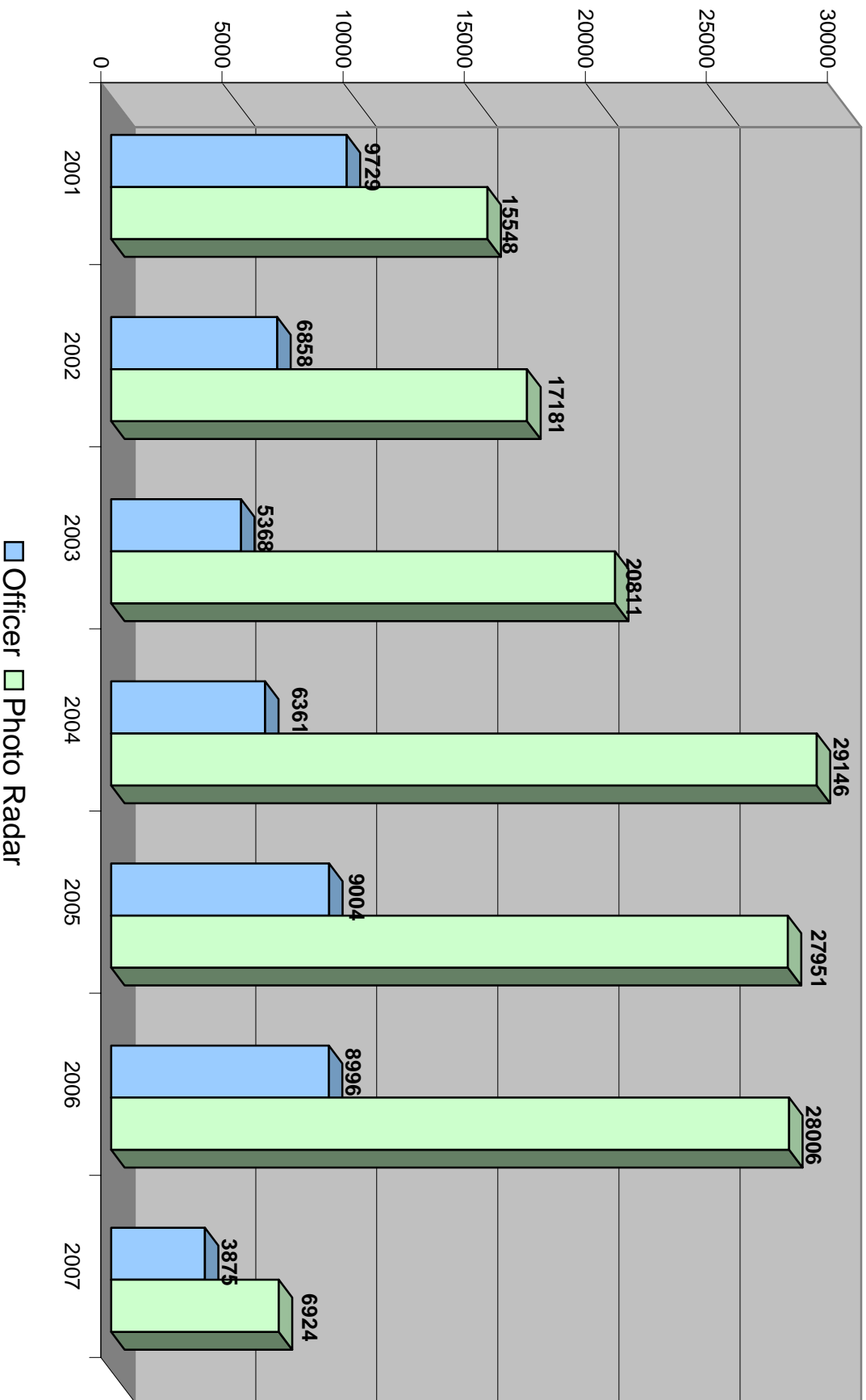

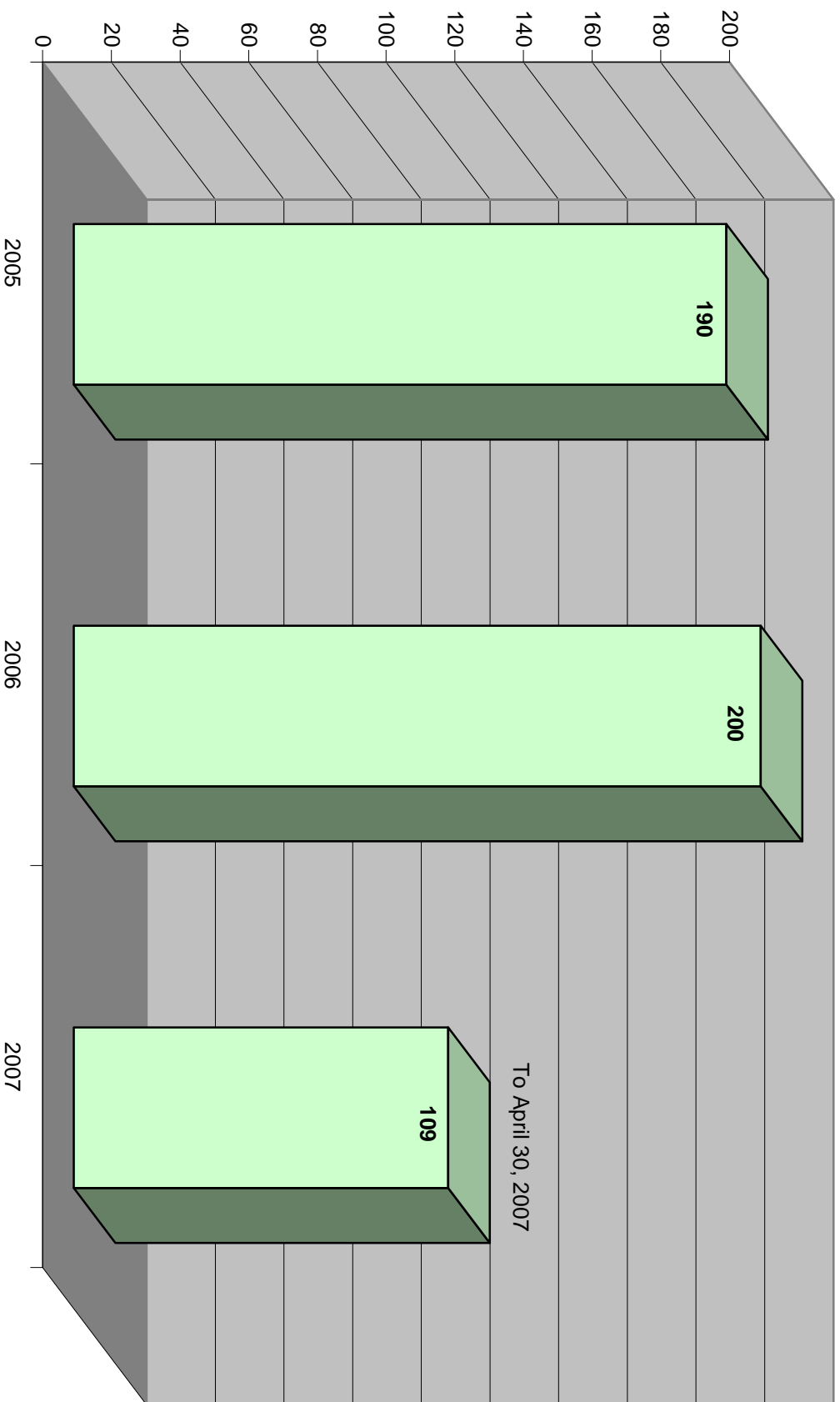

# Tickets Issued

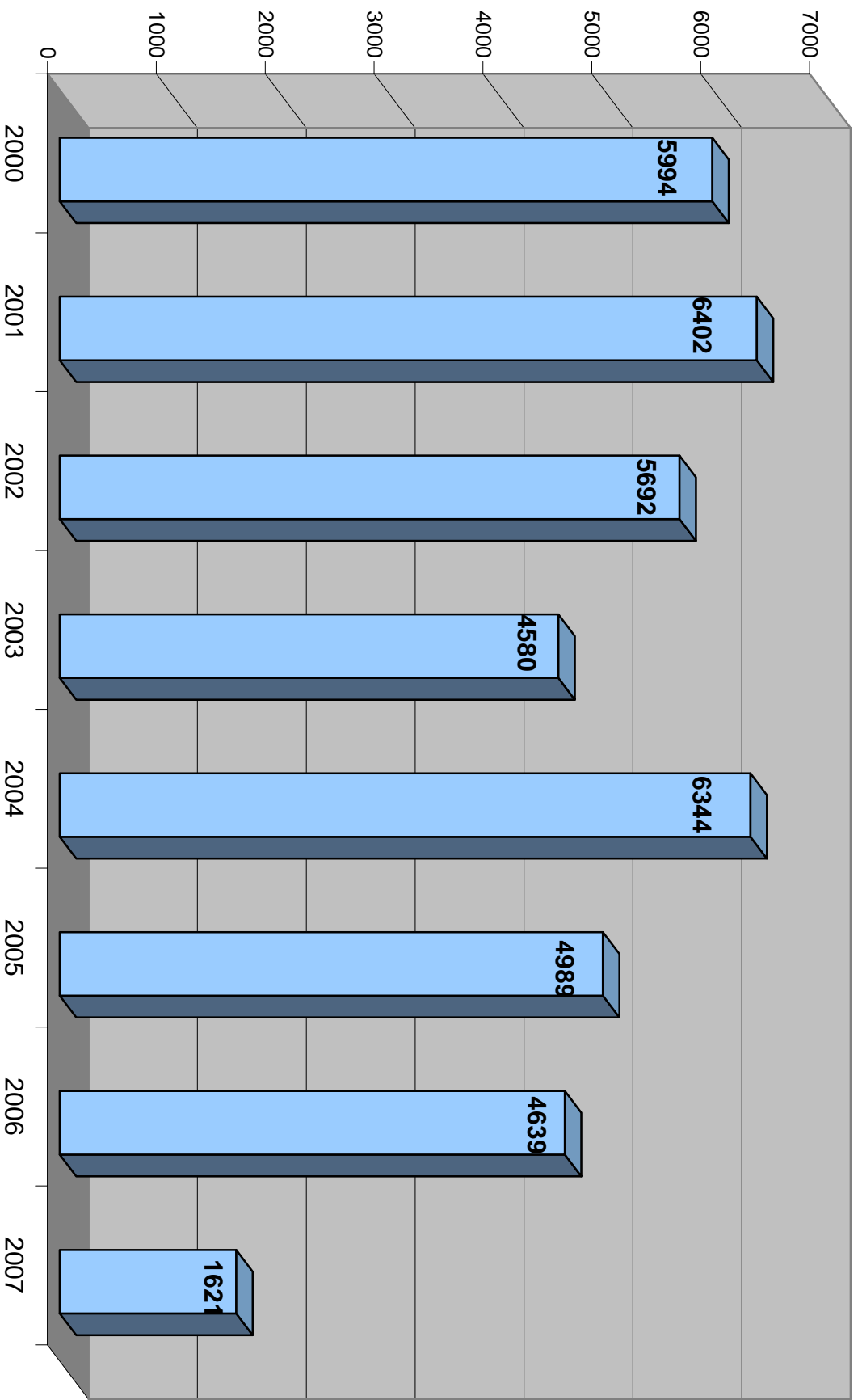


### Impaired Driving Charges (Includes Exceed & Refuse)
