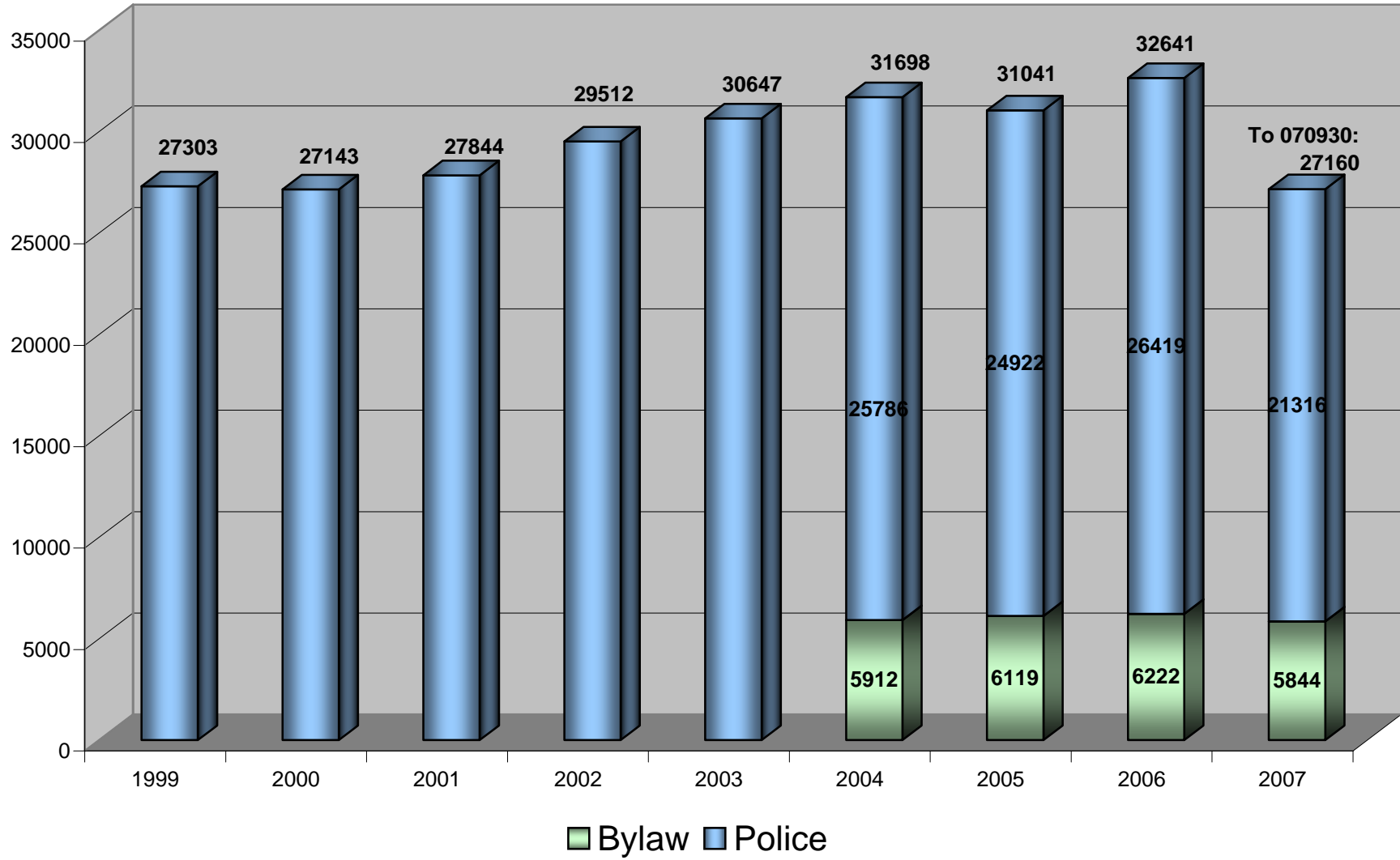

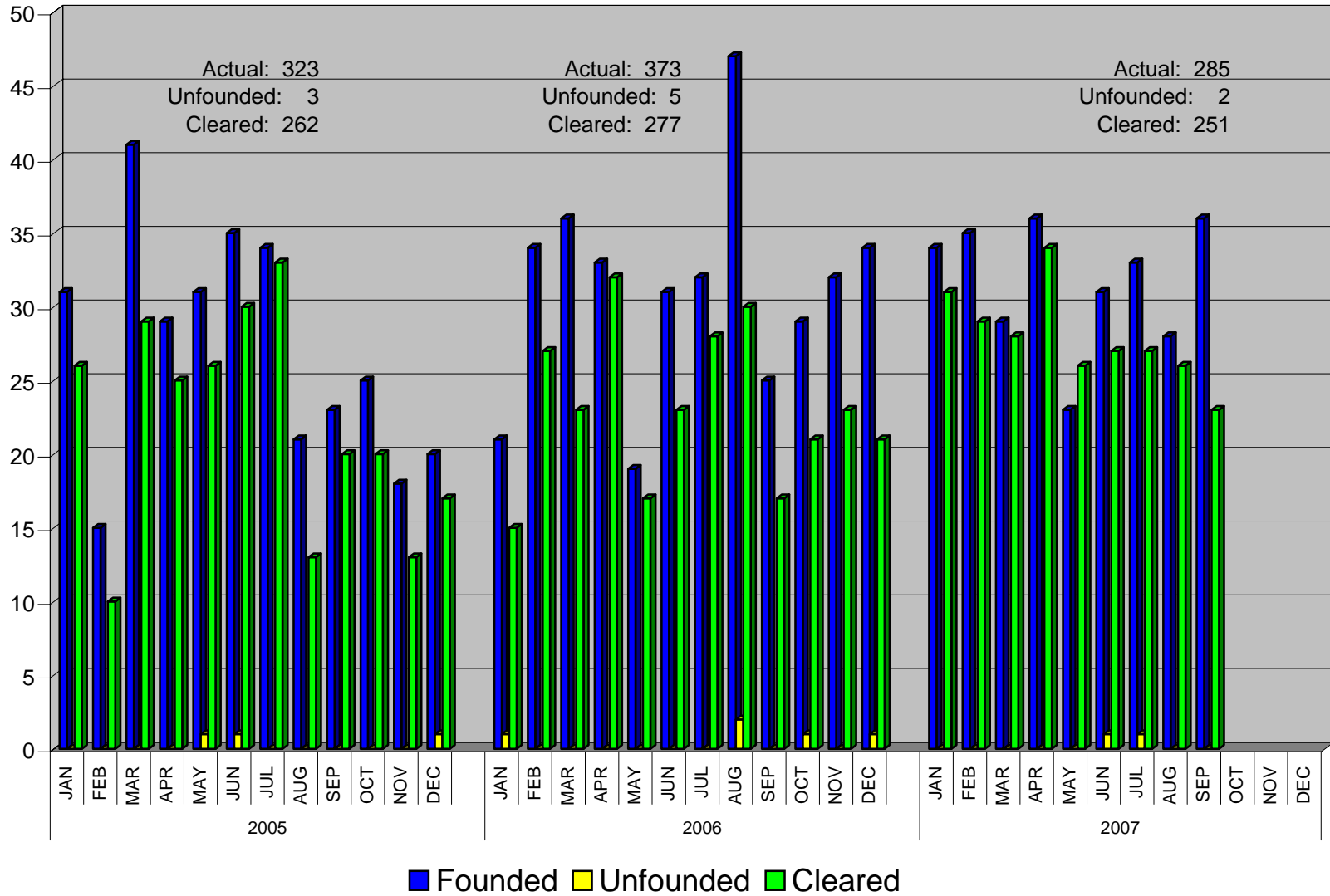

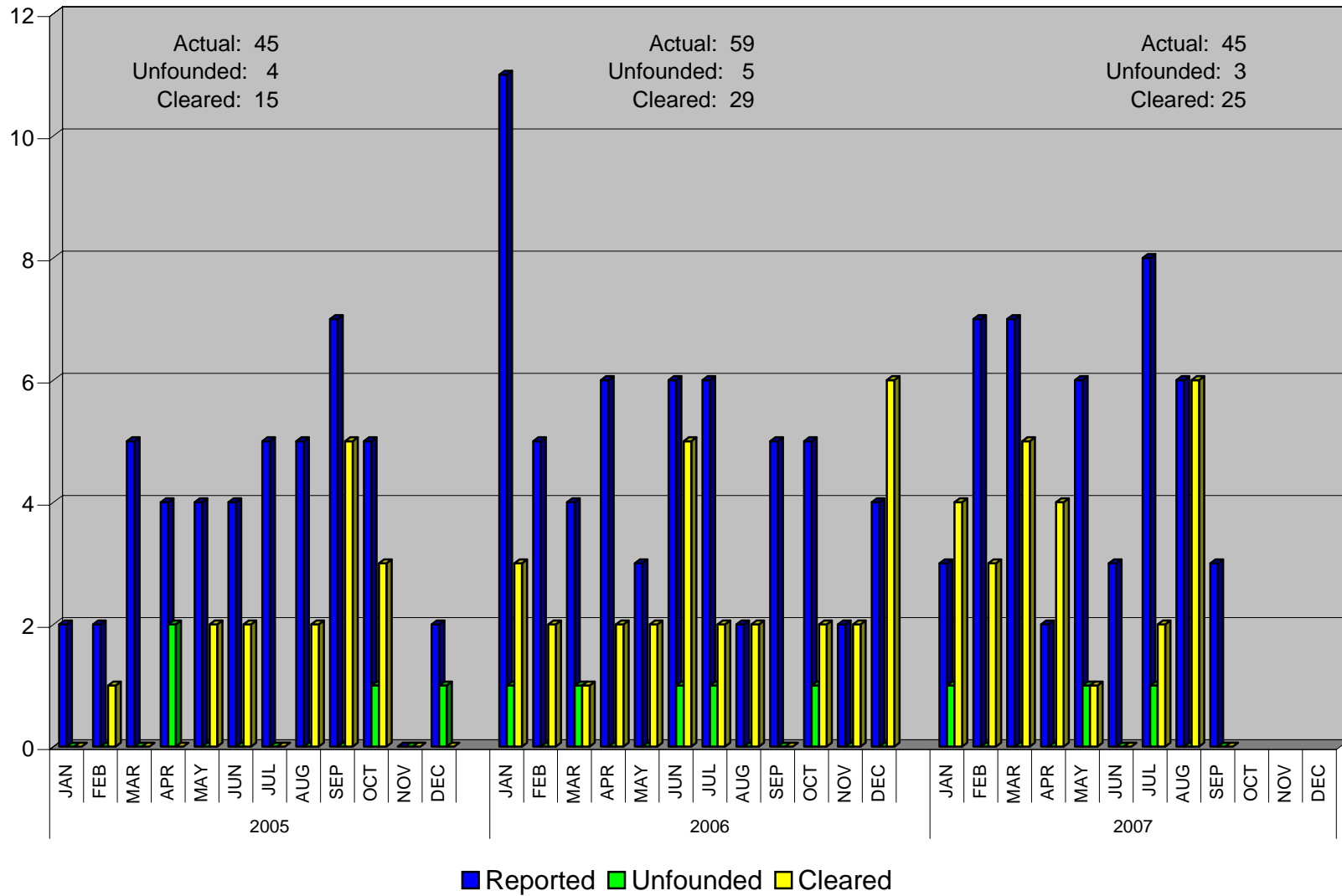
Assaults

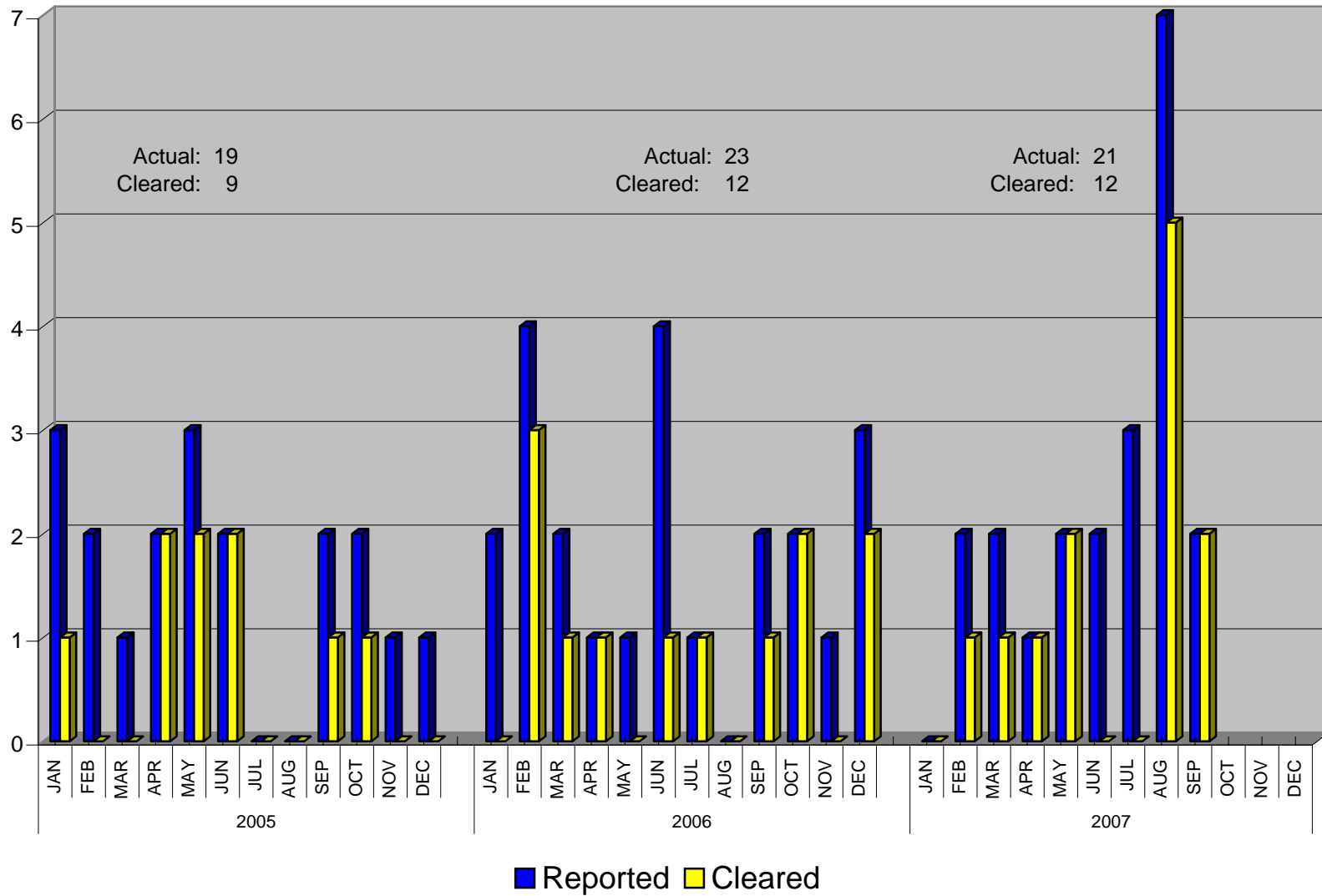
Sexual Assault

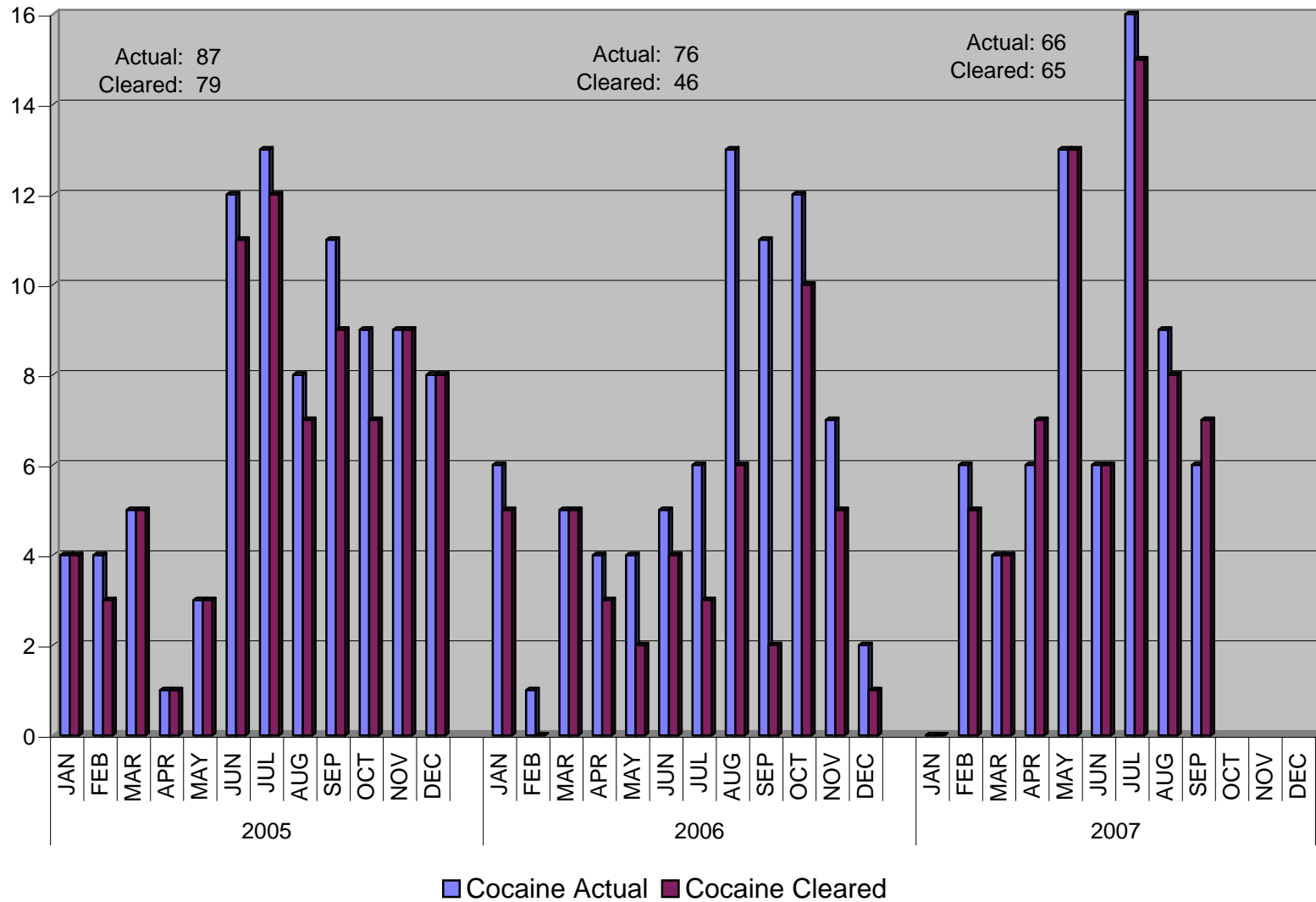


Robbery

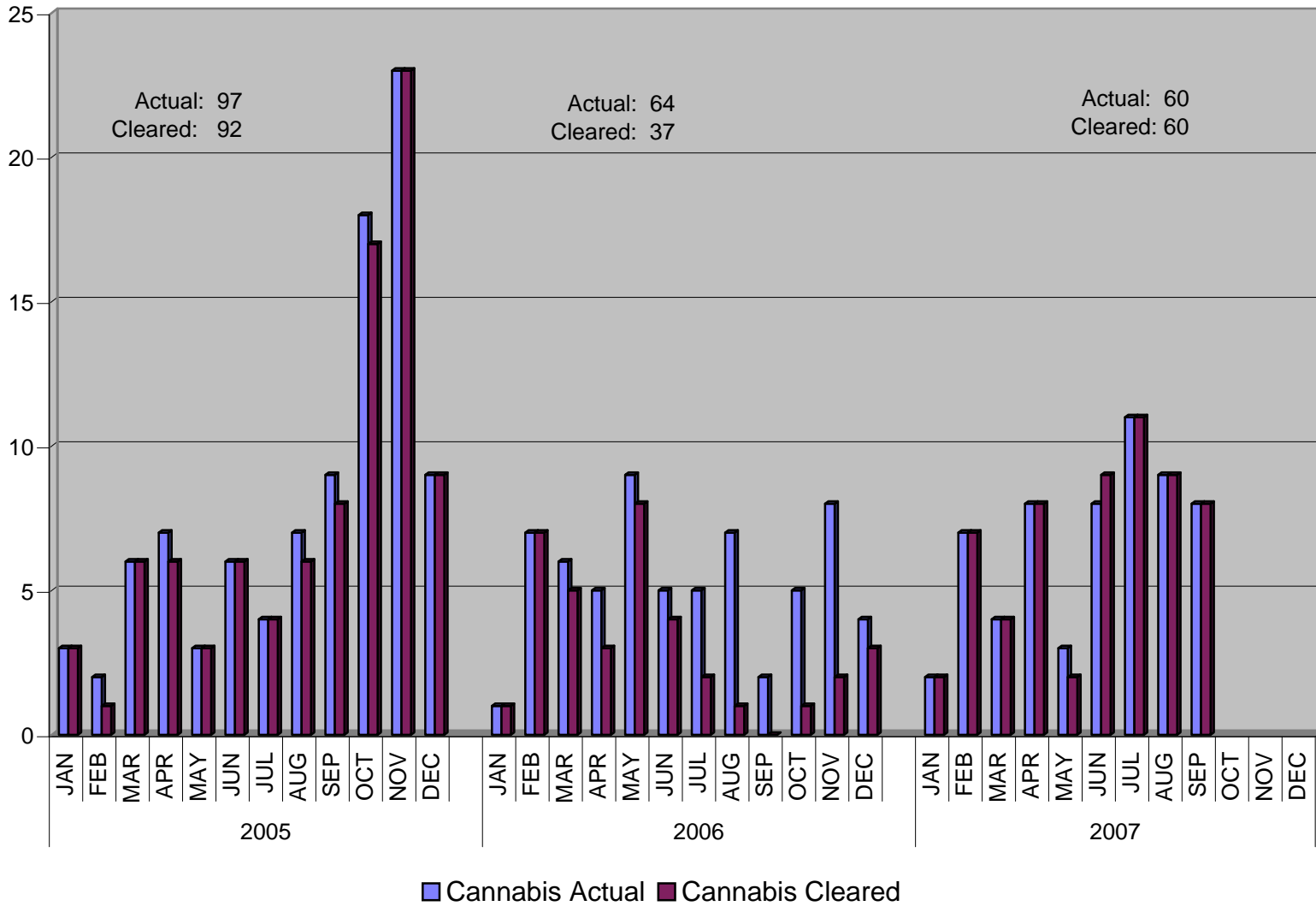

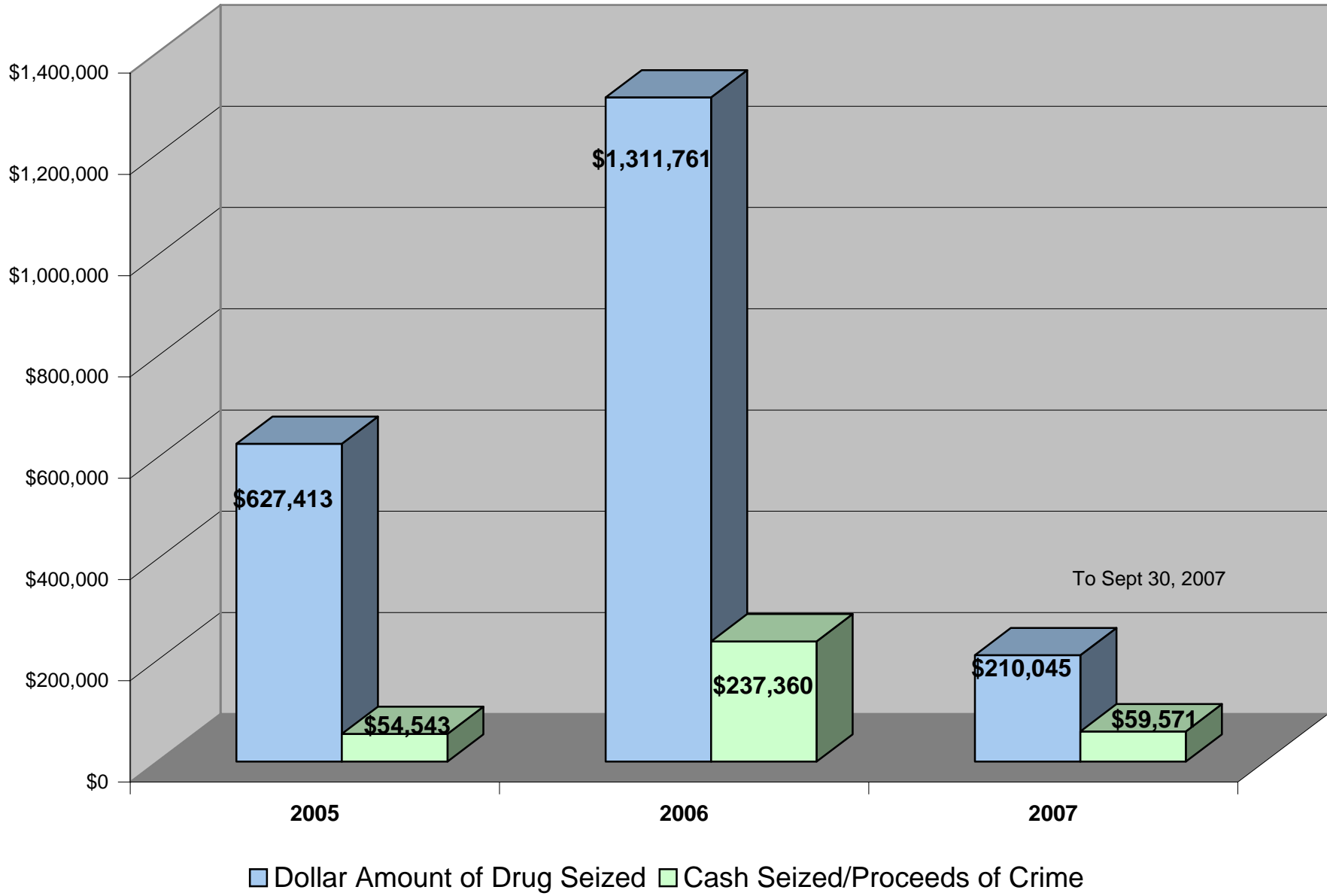


Narcotic Offences - Cocaine



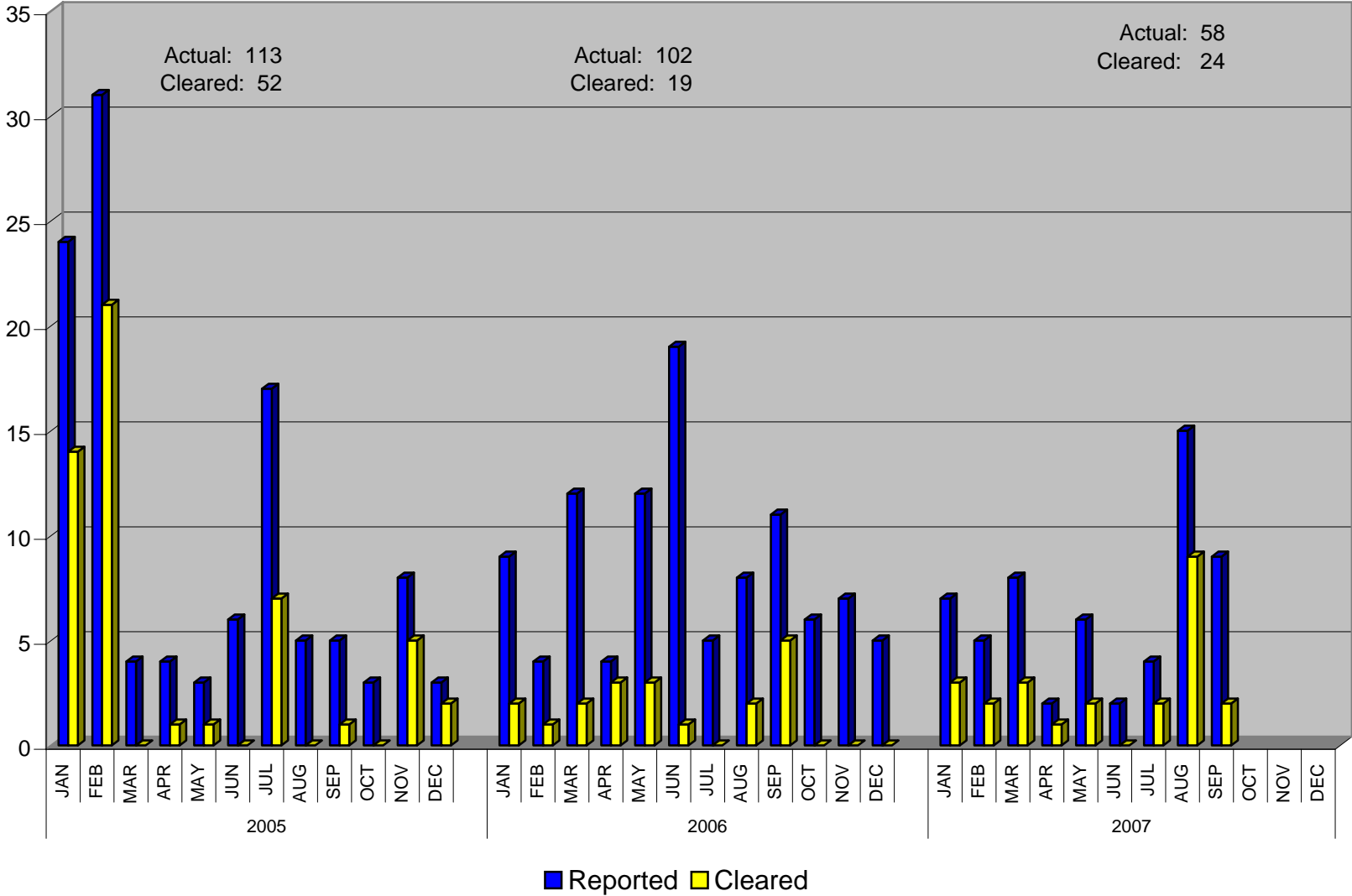
Narcotic Offences - Cannabis





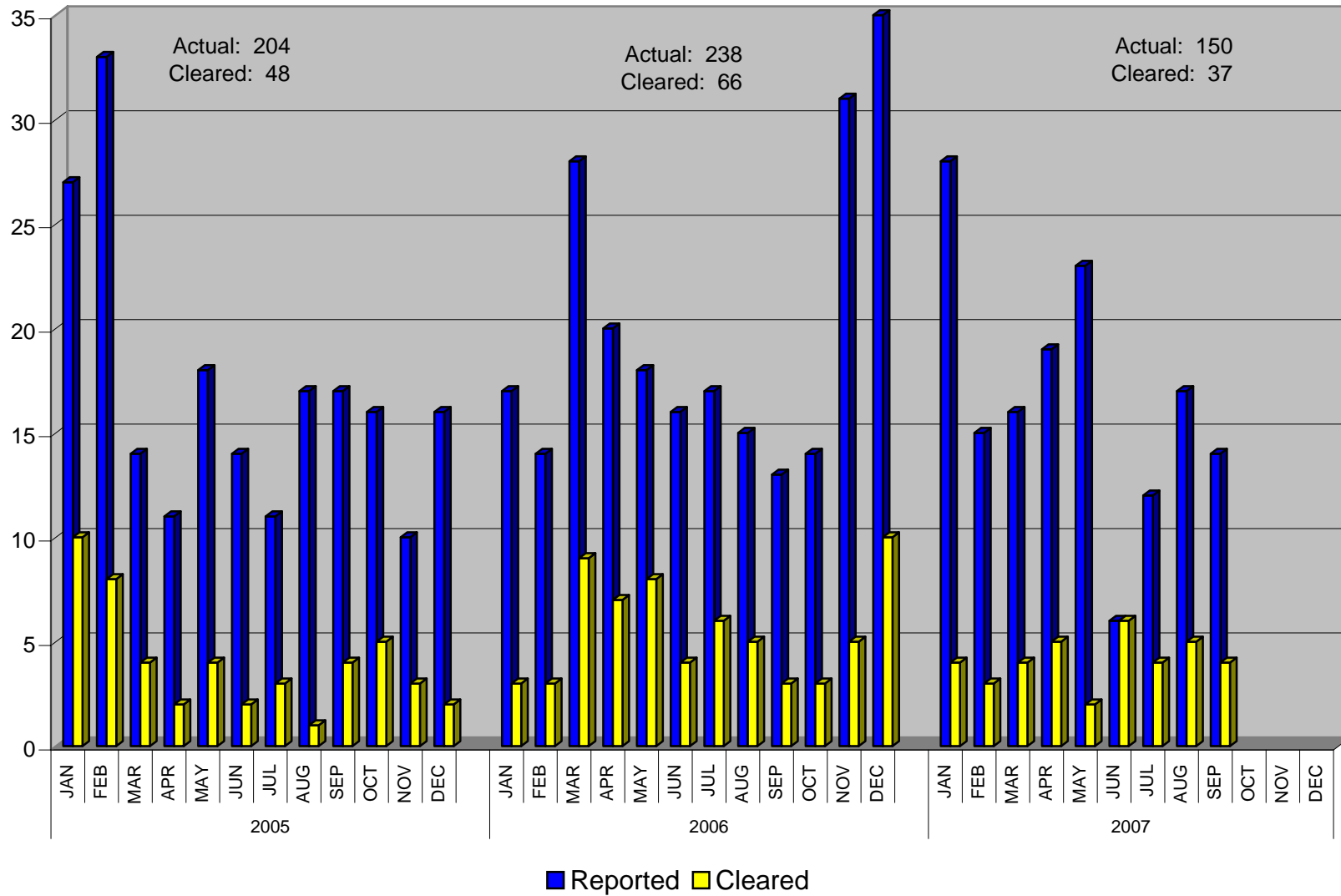
B & E Business

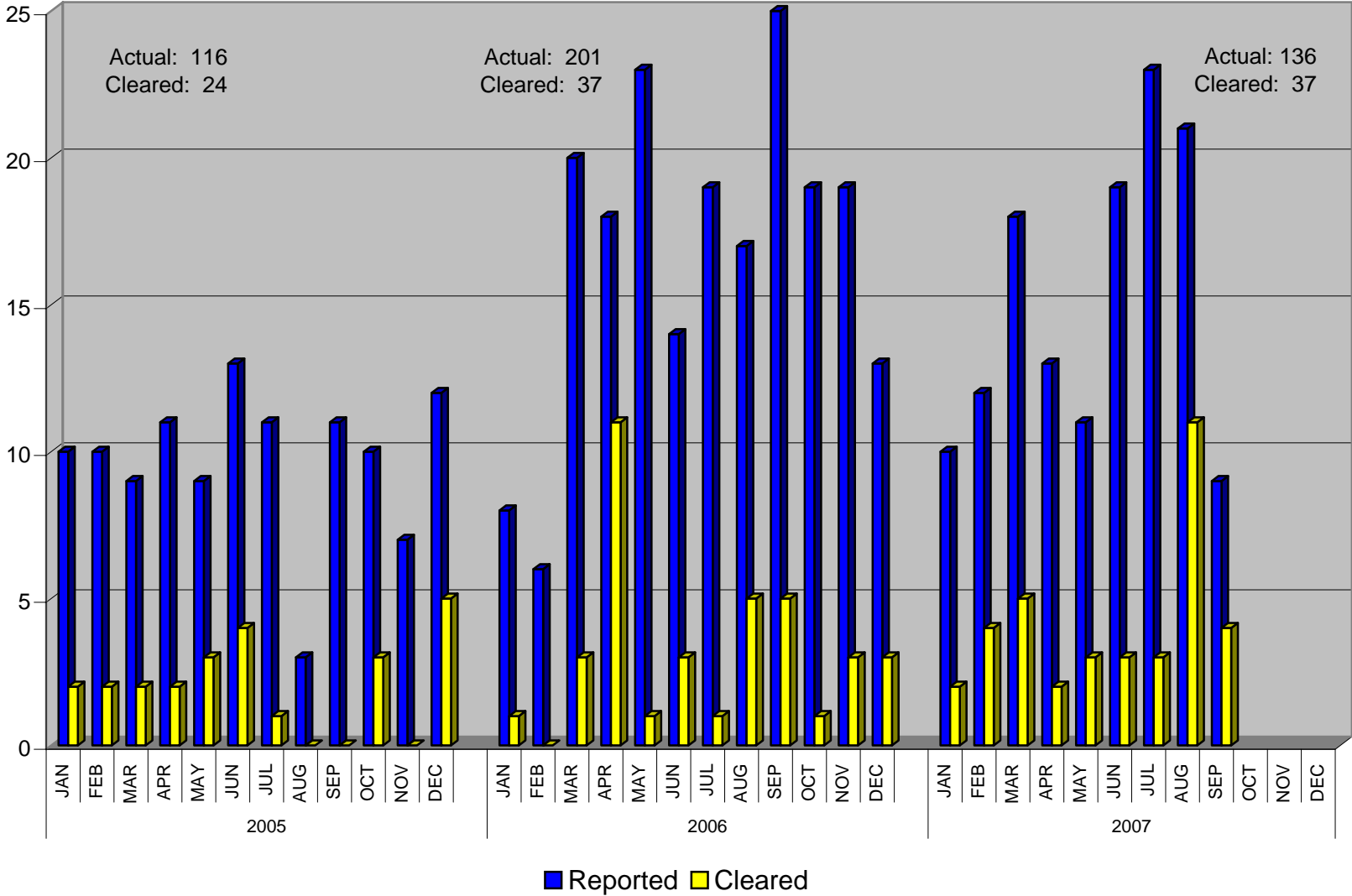
B & E Residence

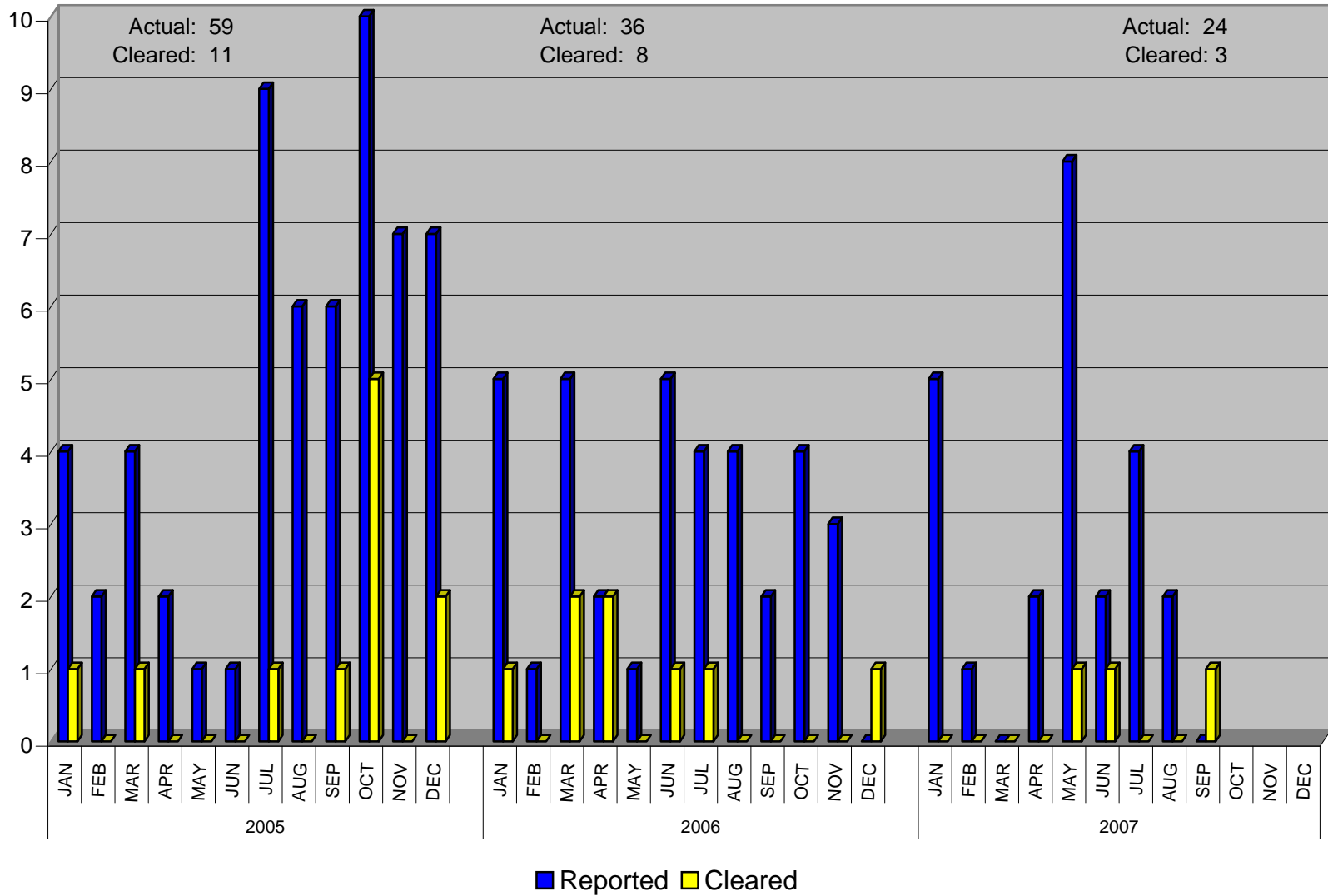
Theft Motor Vehicle

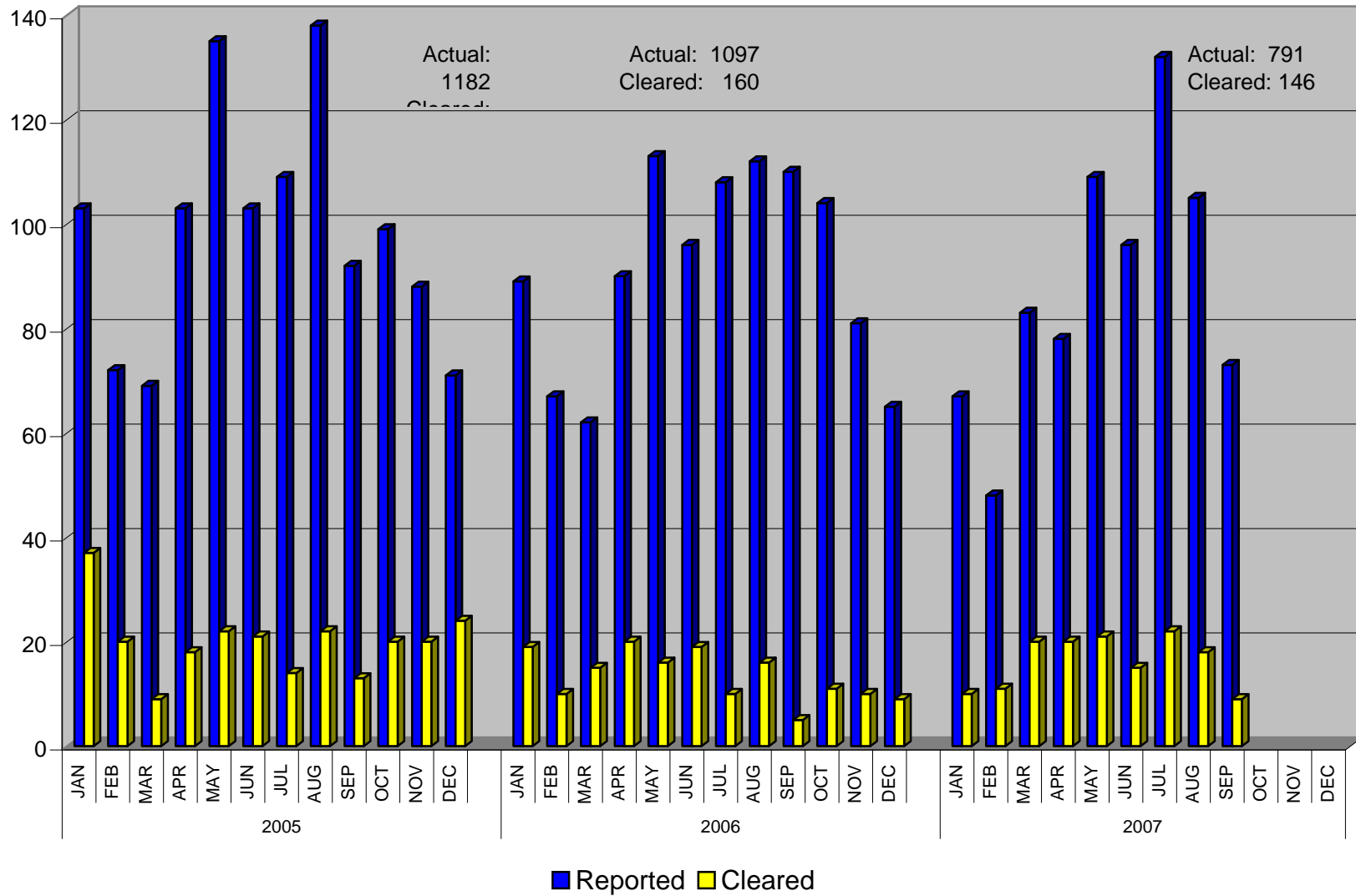
Theft Over

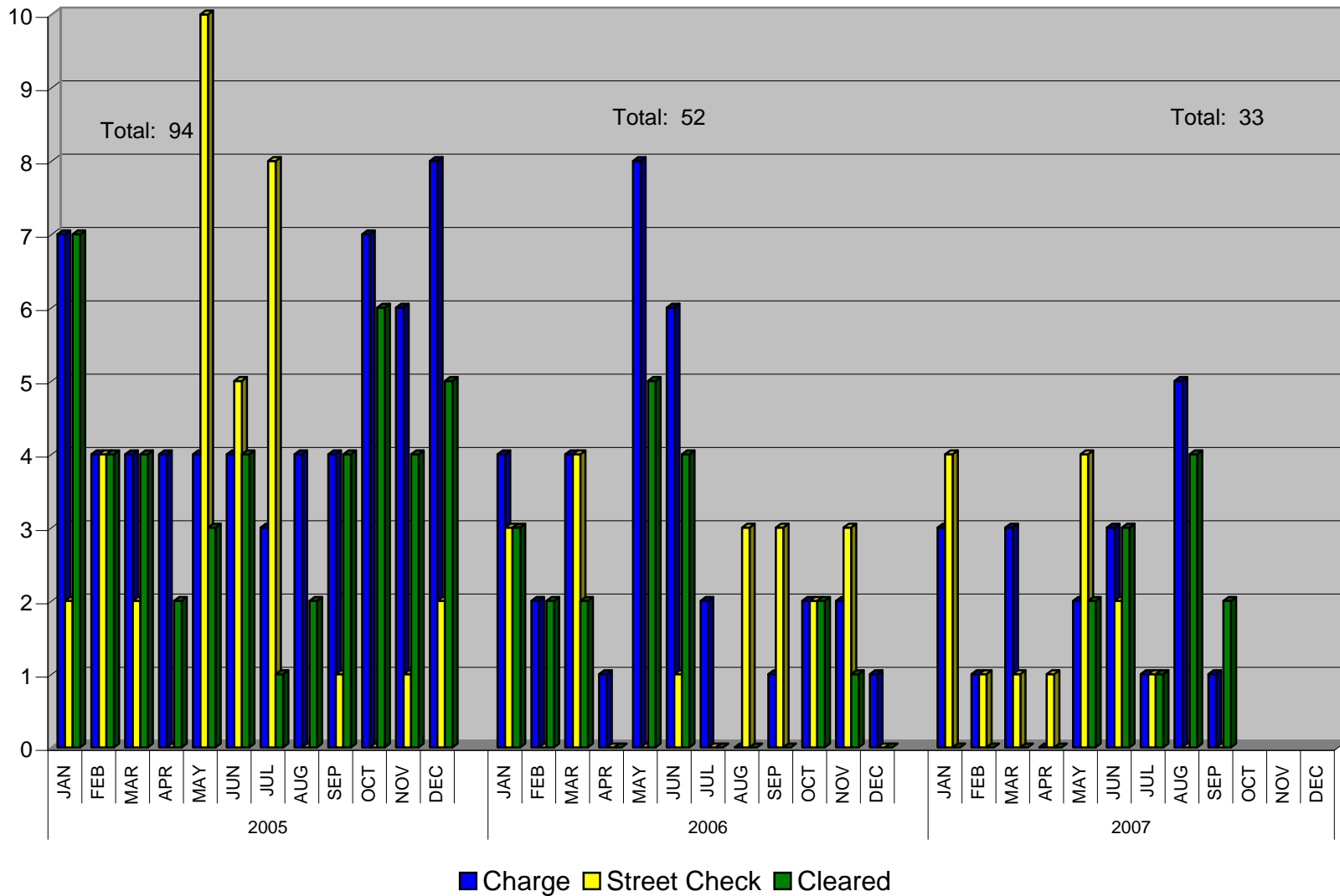
Theft Under

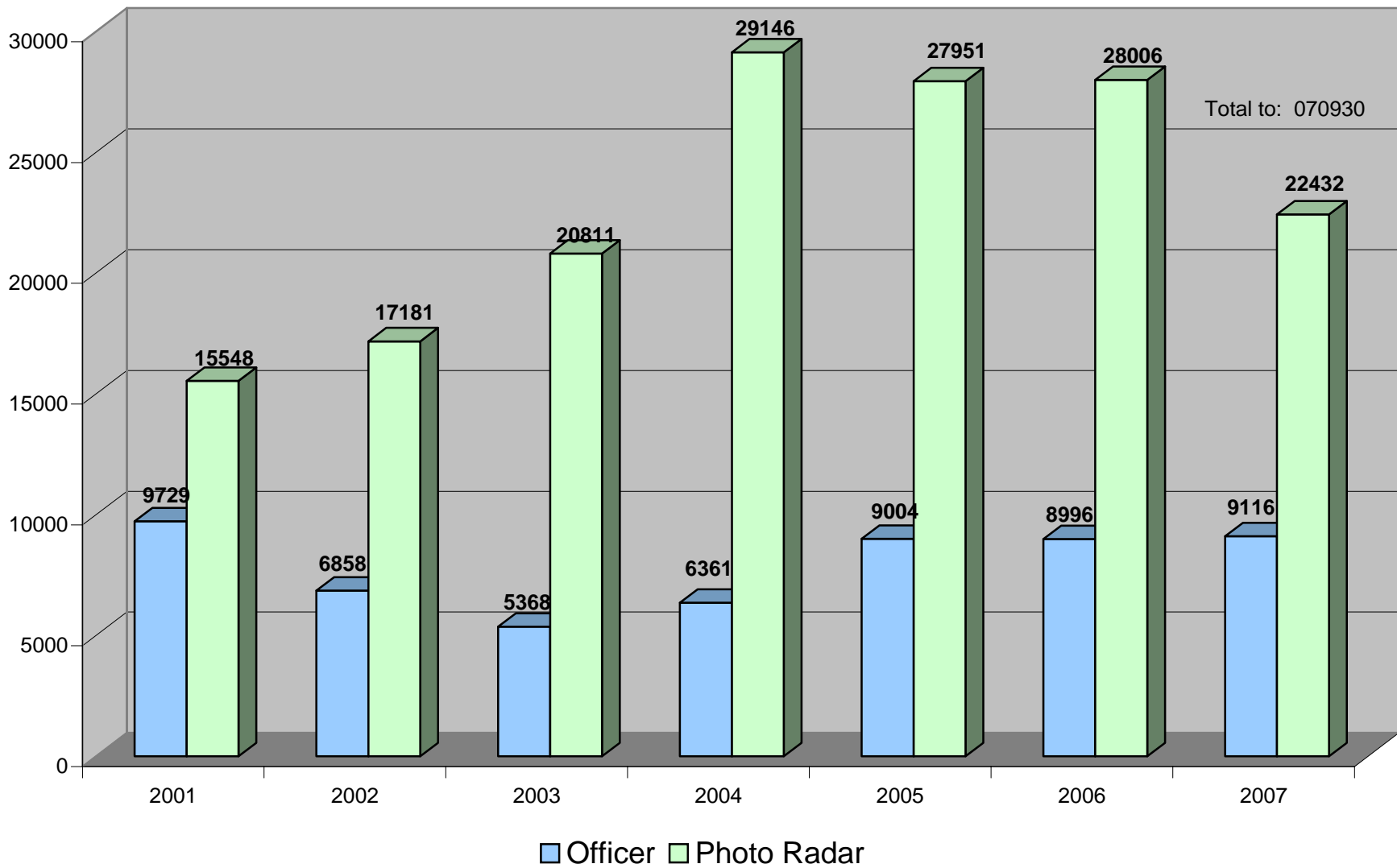

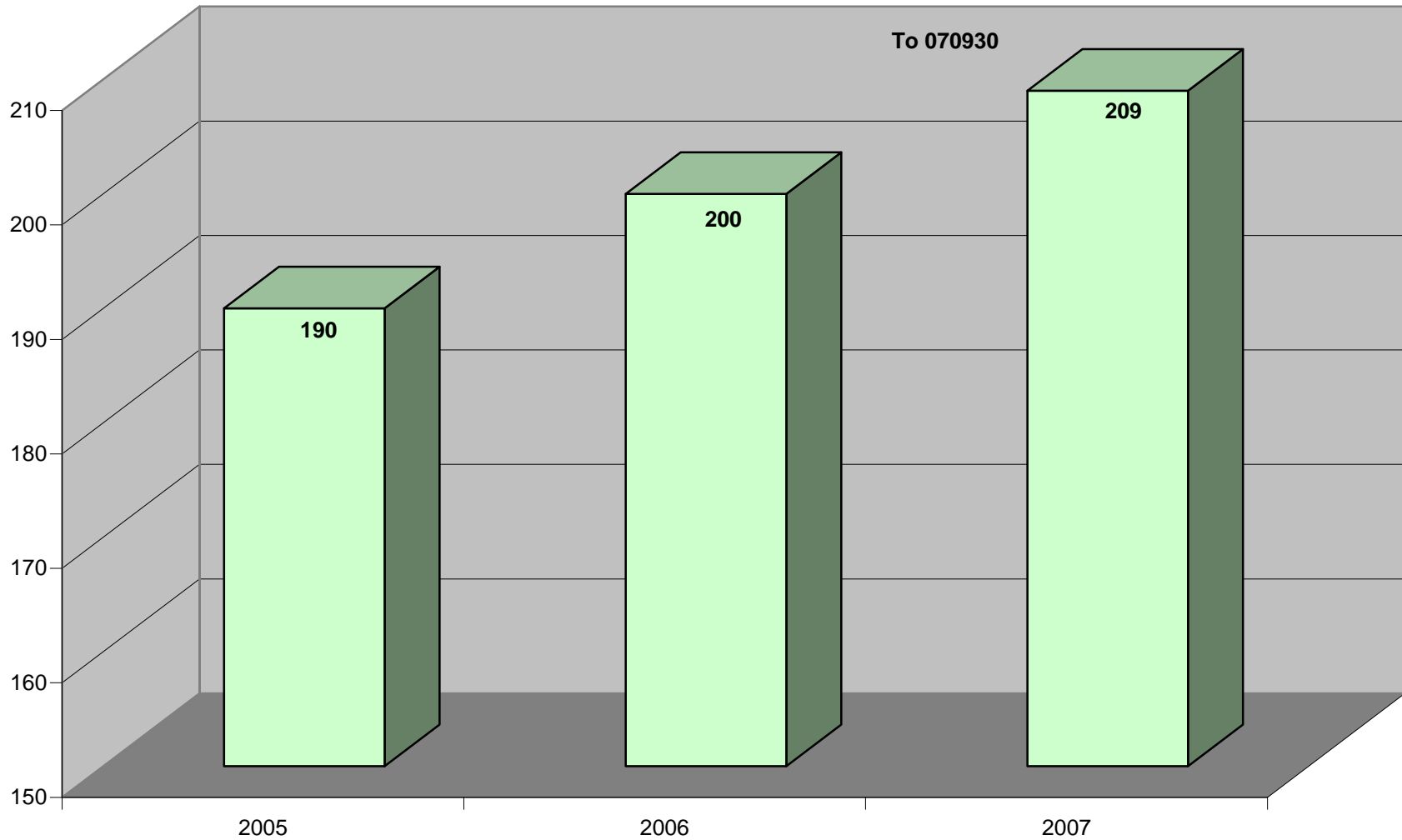

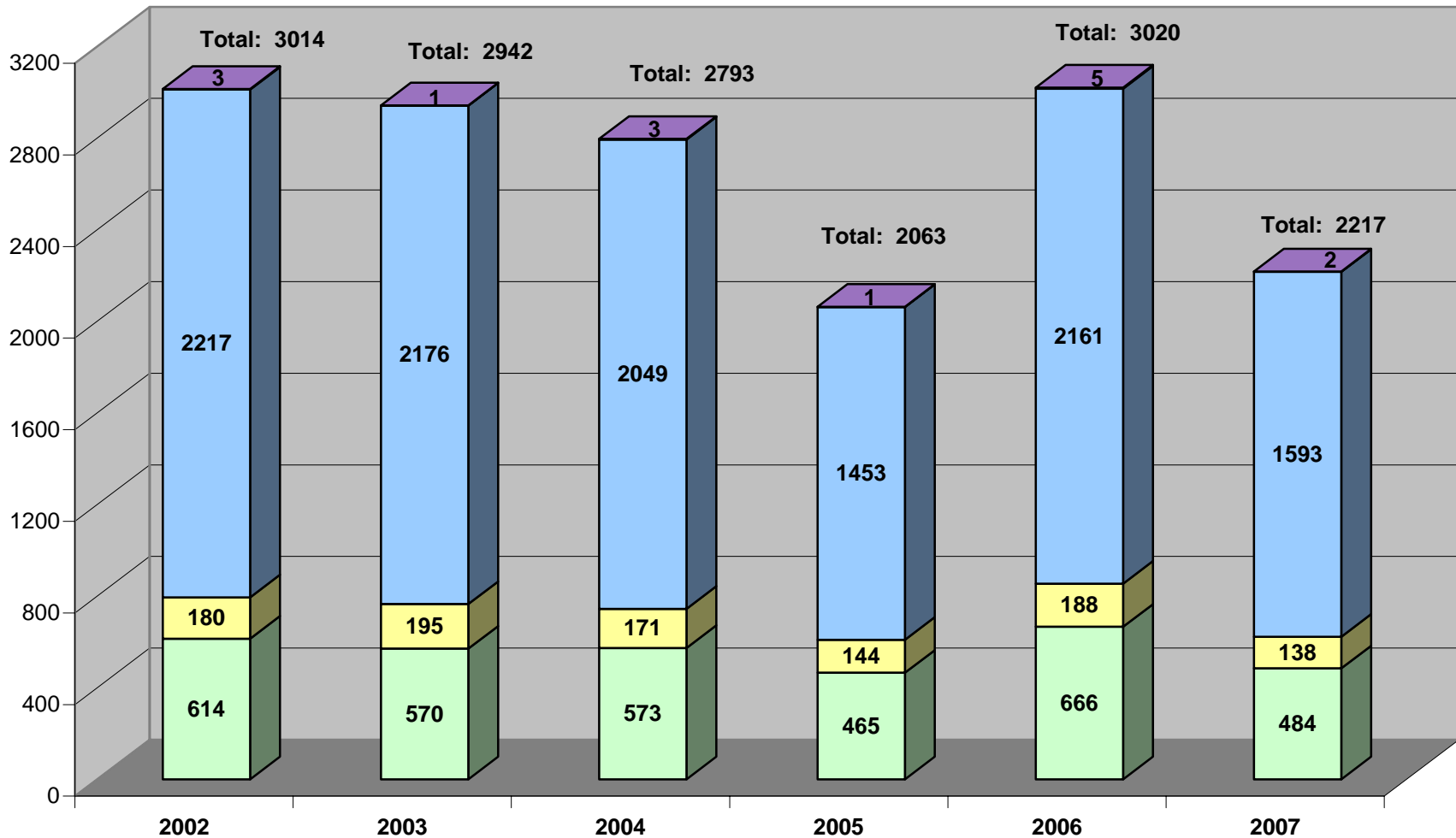
Tickets Issued

Traffic Accident Stats

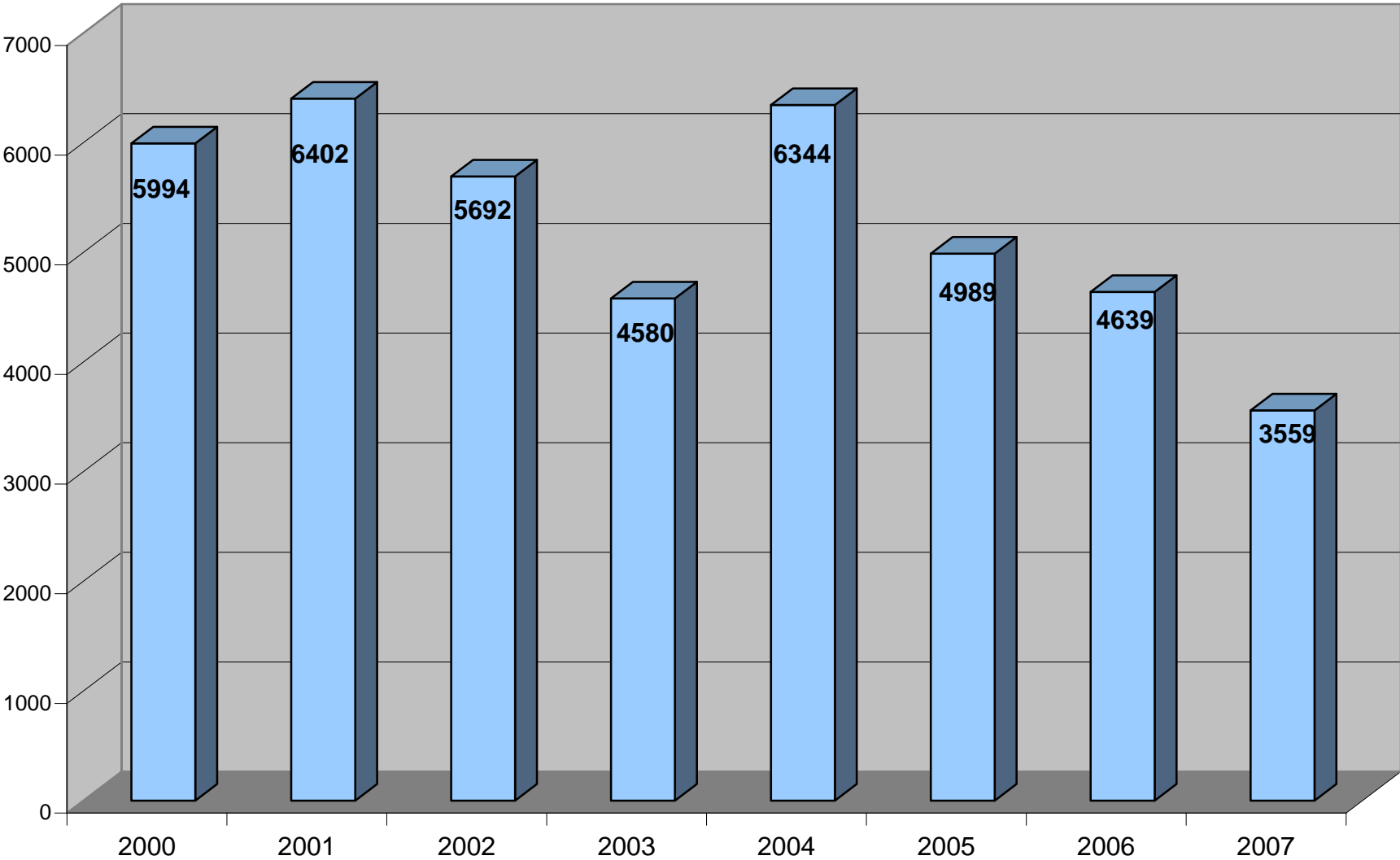

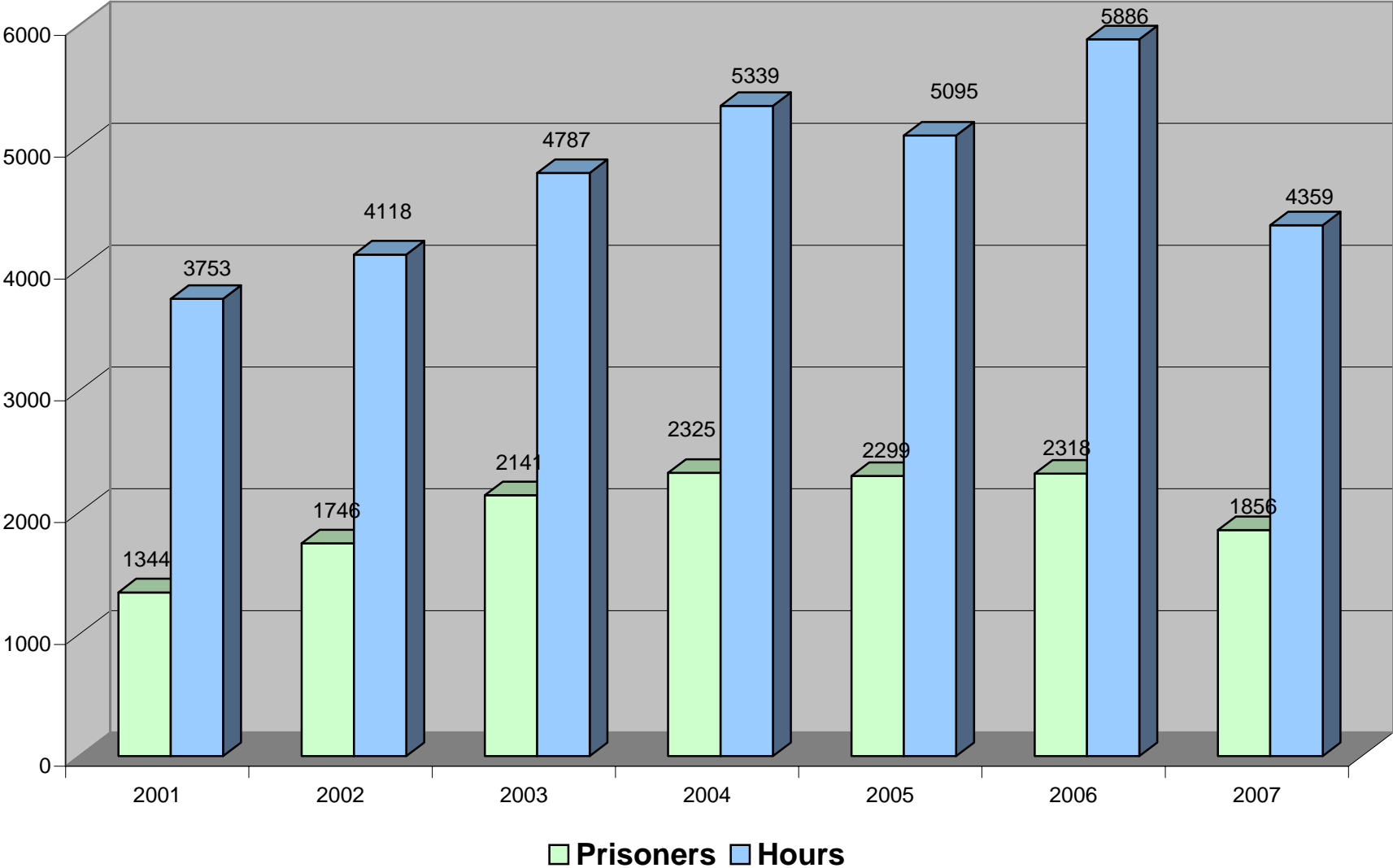
