4. NEW BUSINESS

A) Alarm Bylaw

Inspector Wigle provided an update on the status of the Alarm Systems Bylaw 3716. The bylaw requires all existing alarm systems to be registered within 120 days of the bylaw coming into effect and for any new alarm systems be registered before becoming operational. From now until September involves transitioning with continued education prior to the enforcement stage. The top ten offenders will receive warning letters and direct contact from Inspector Wigle. Throughout the summer, additional warning letters will be issued as required.

ACTION: Inspector Wigle will prepare a media release regarding the Alarm Bylaw.

B) Community Survey

ACTION: The results of the community survey will be presented at the July 10 meeting.

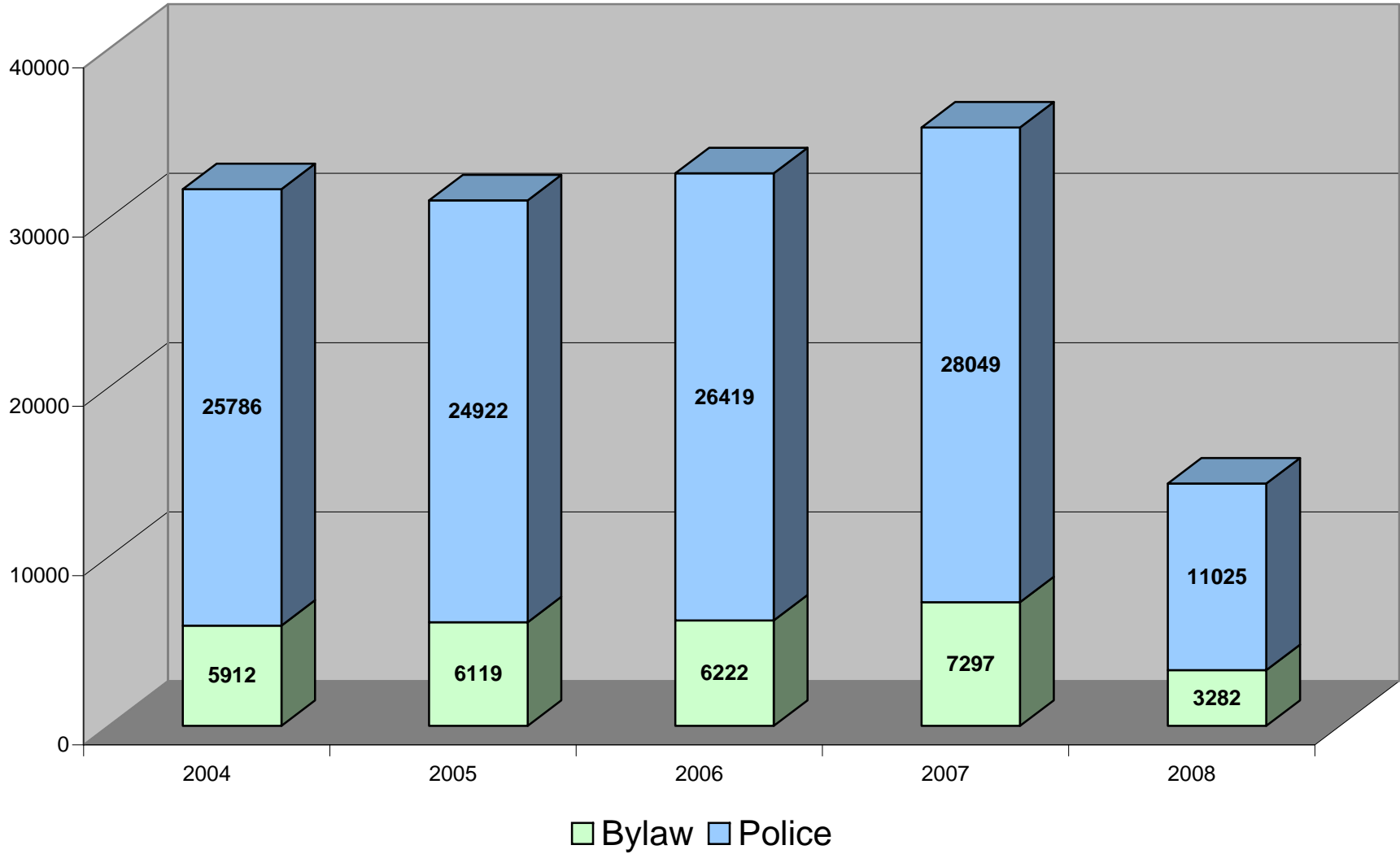

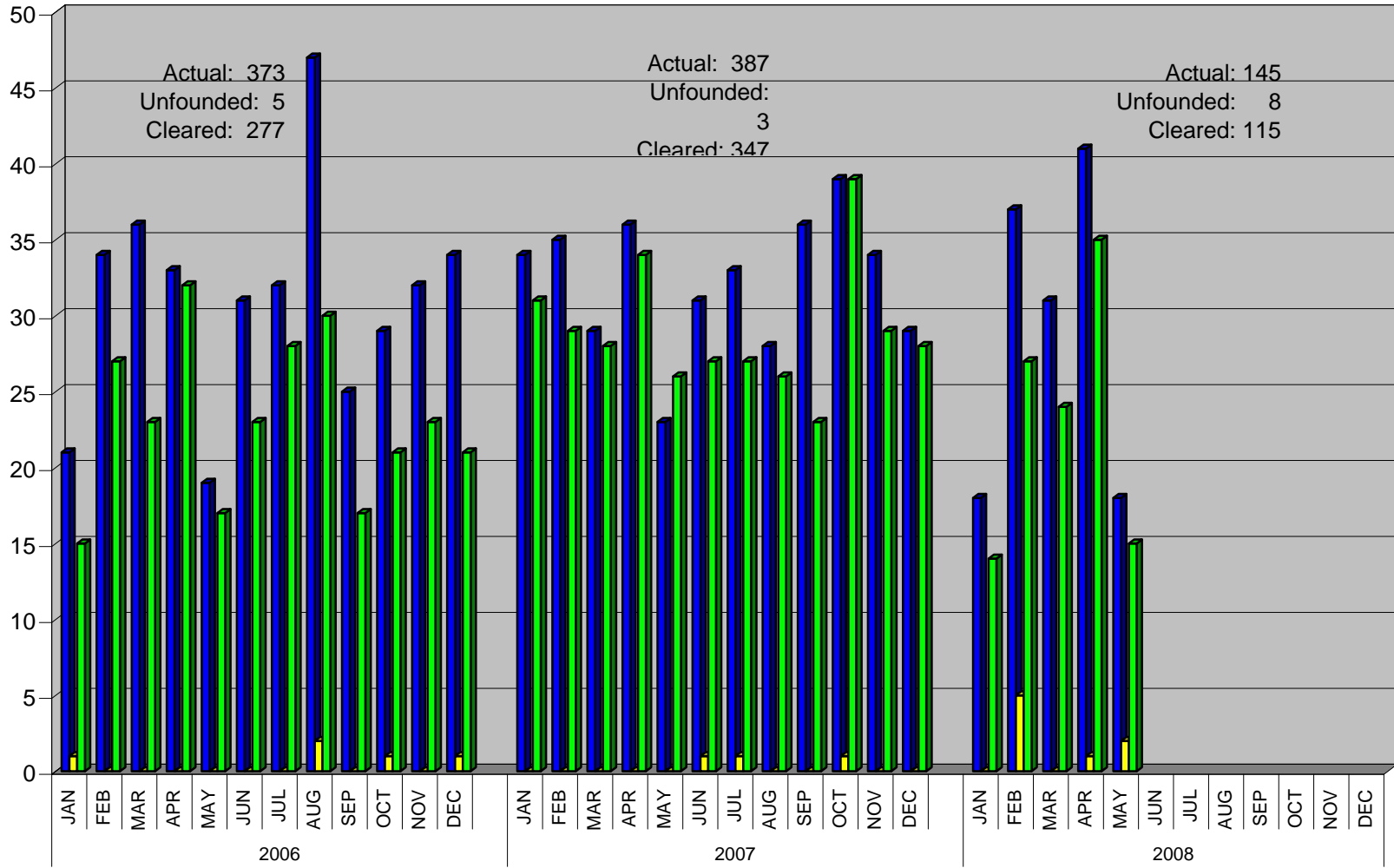

Assaults

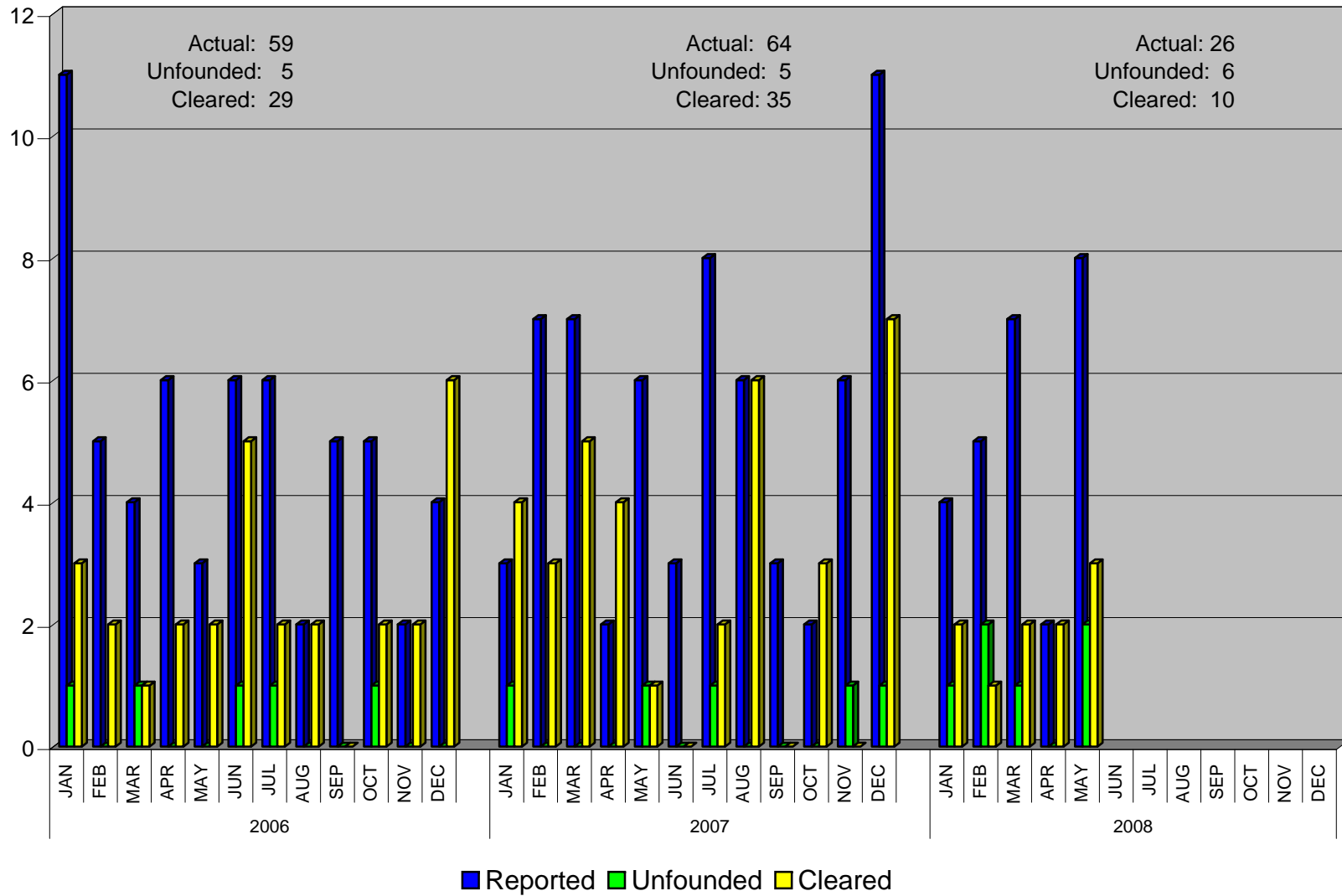

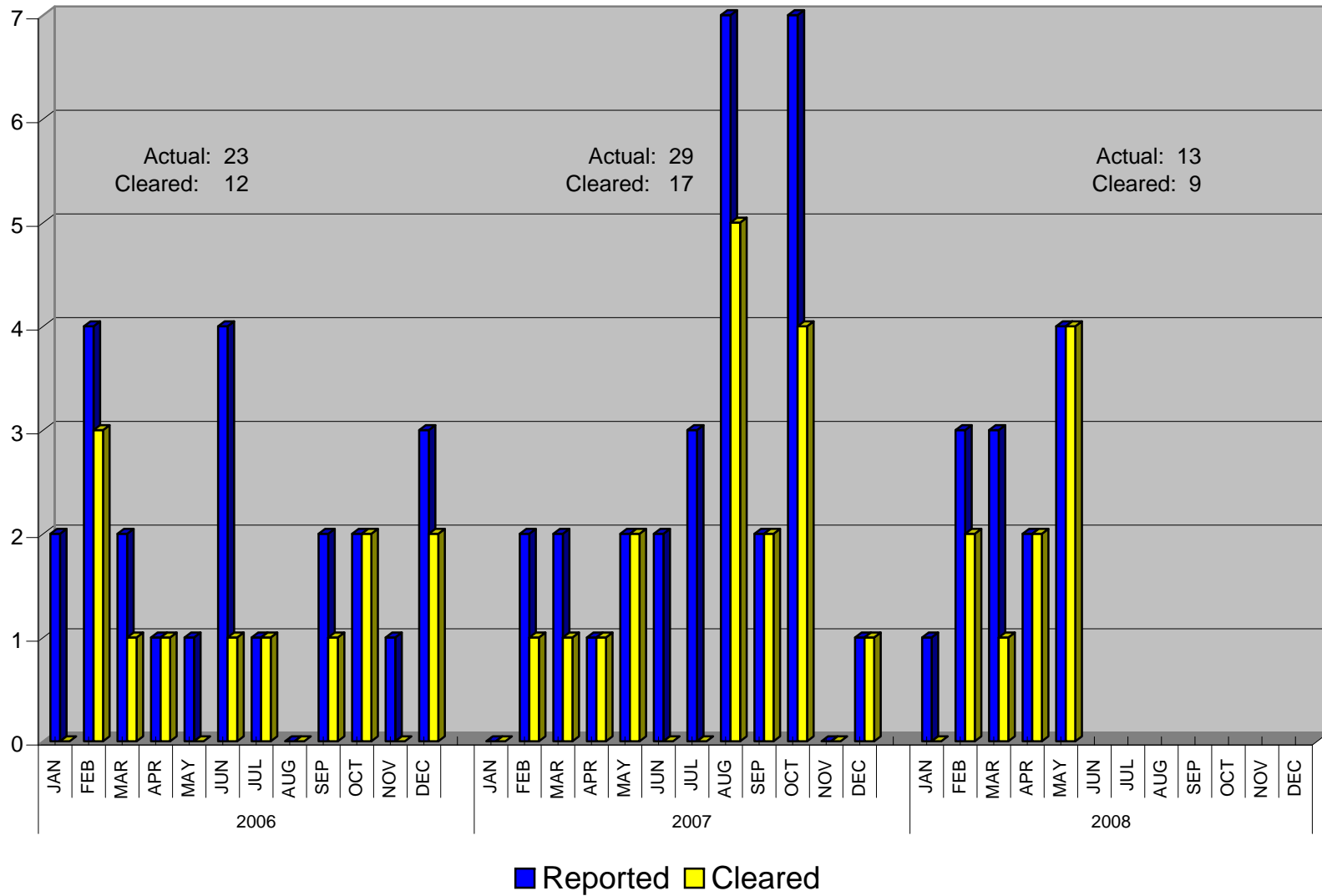
Sexual Assault

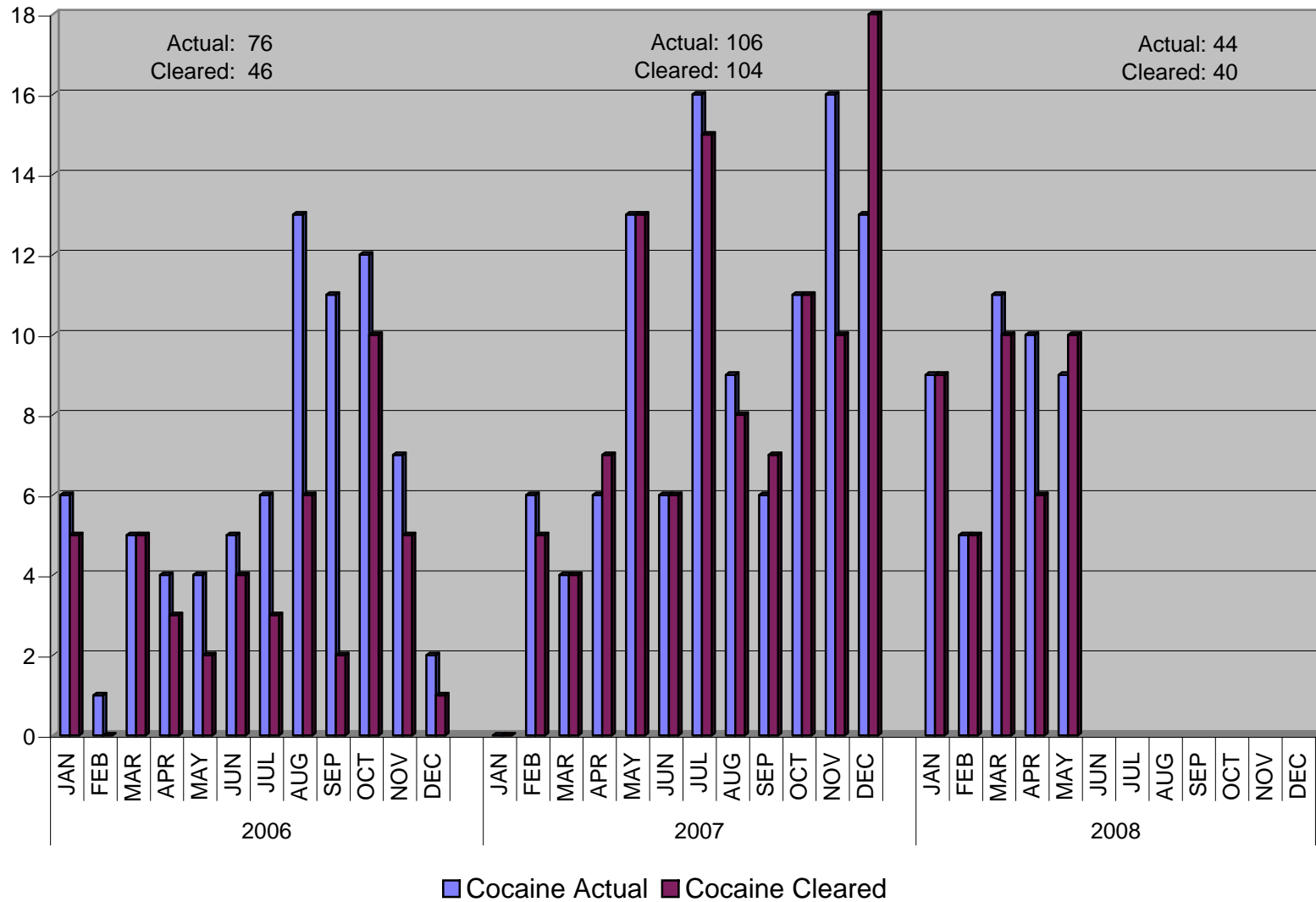


Robbery

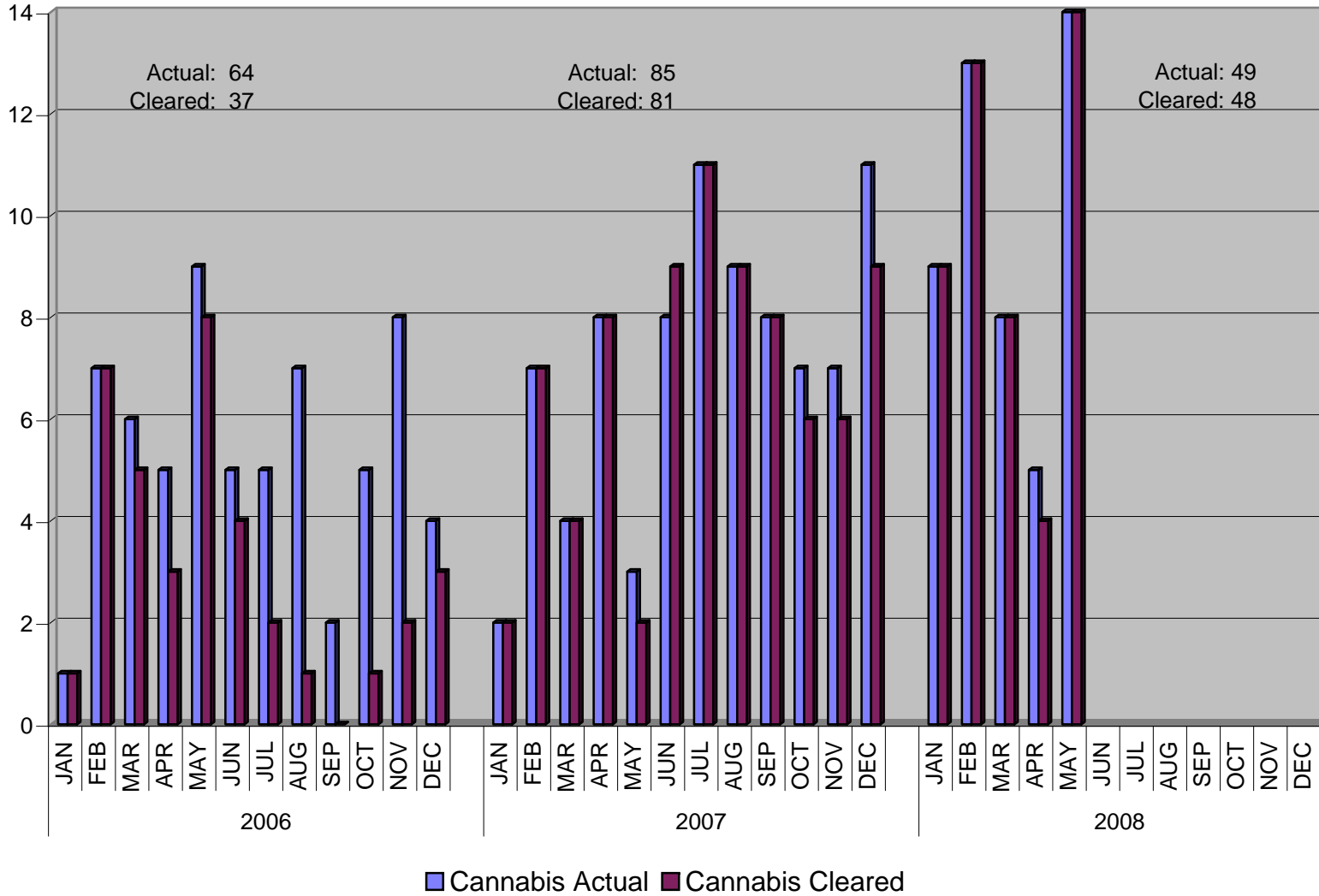

Narcotic Offences - Cocaine

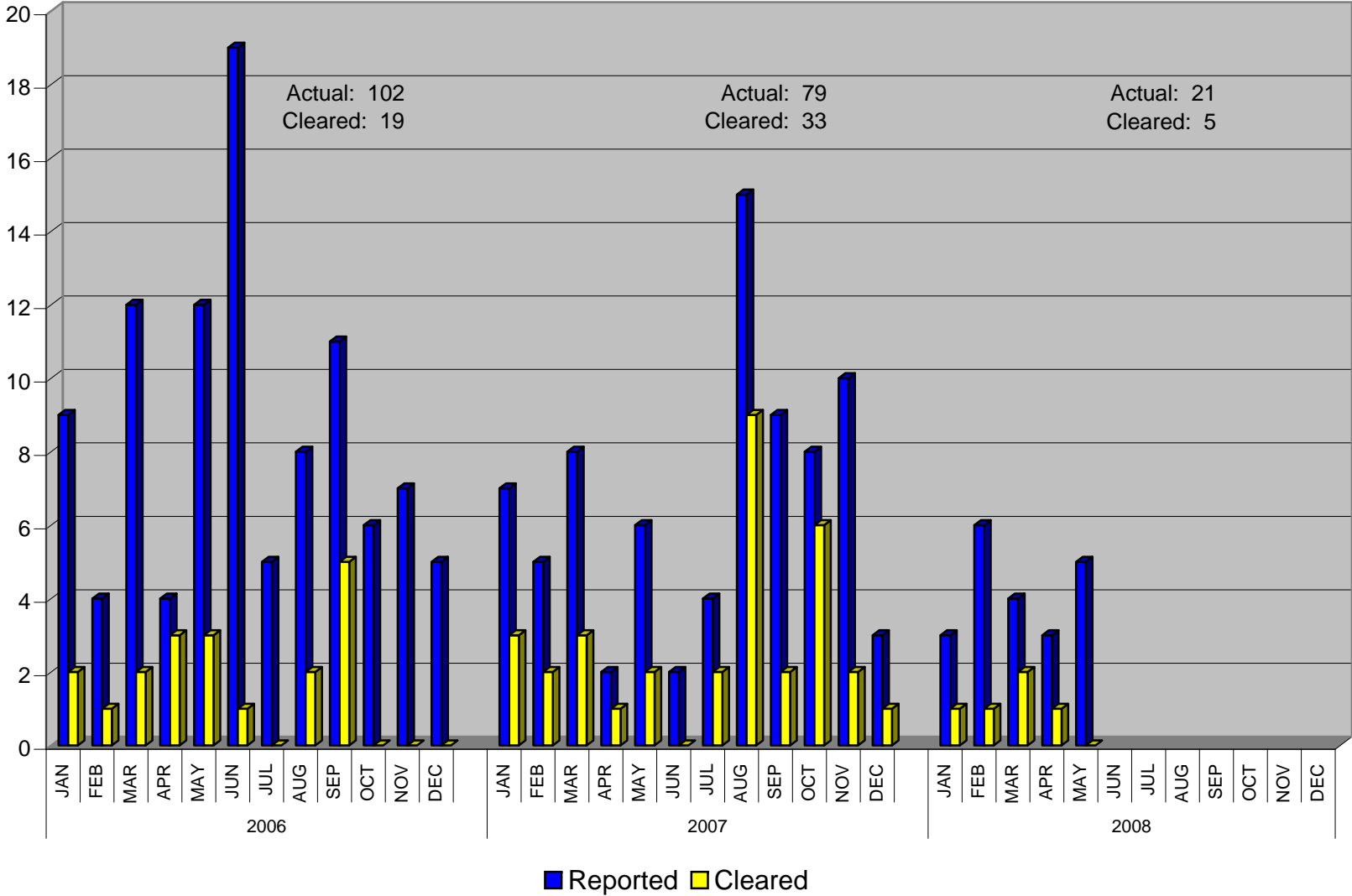


Narcotic Offences - Cannabis



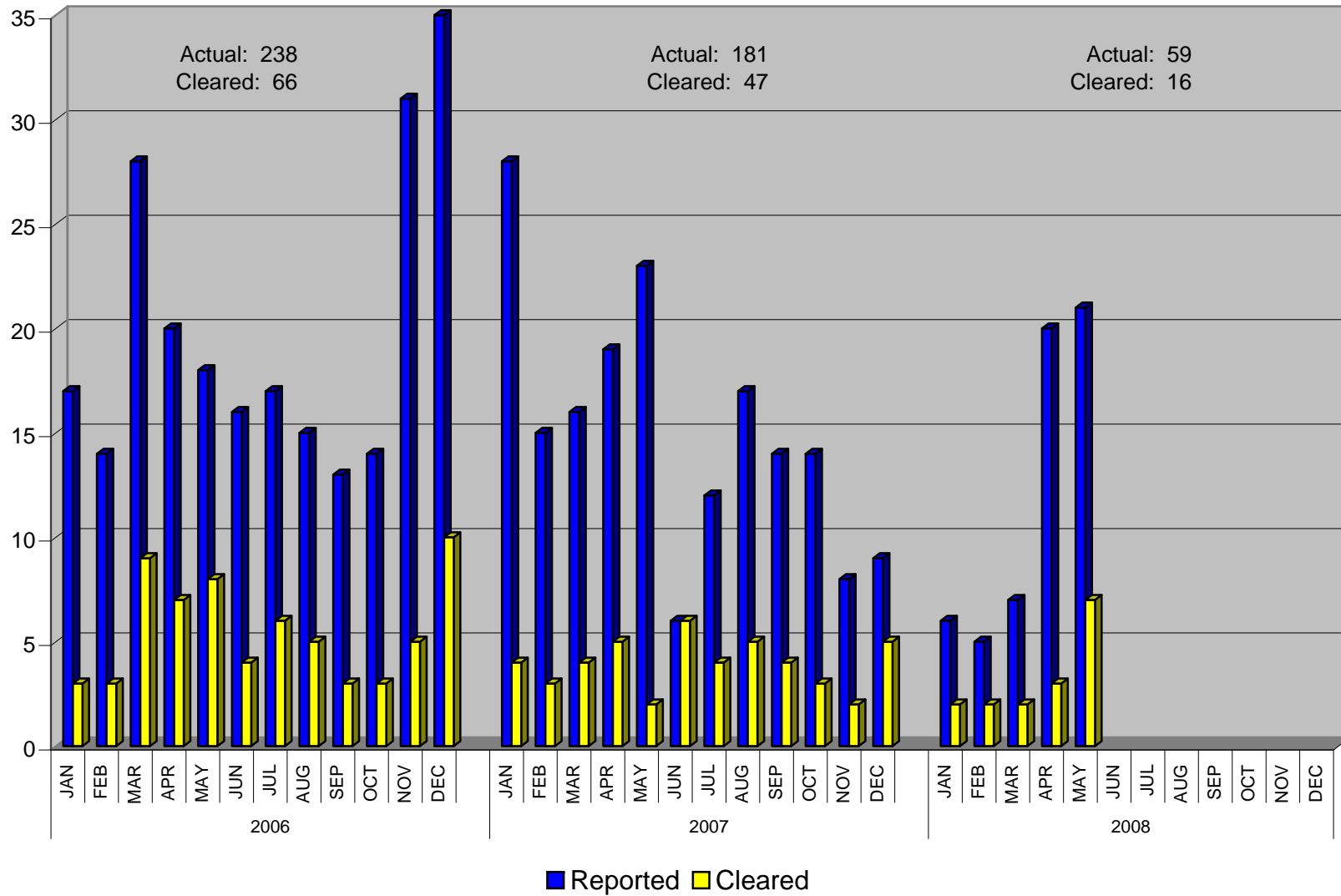

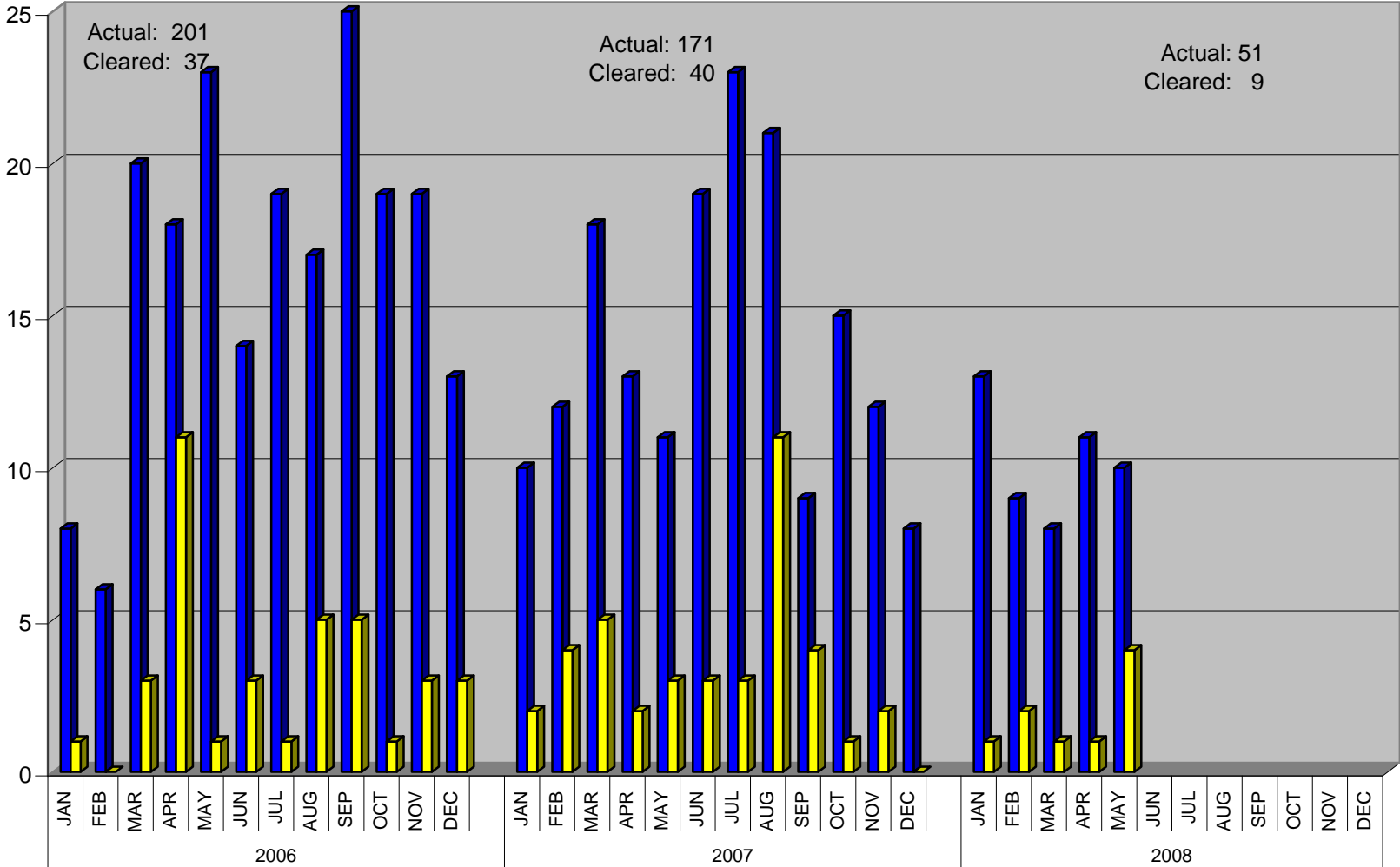
B & E Residence

Theft Motor Vehicle

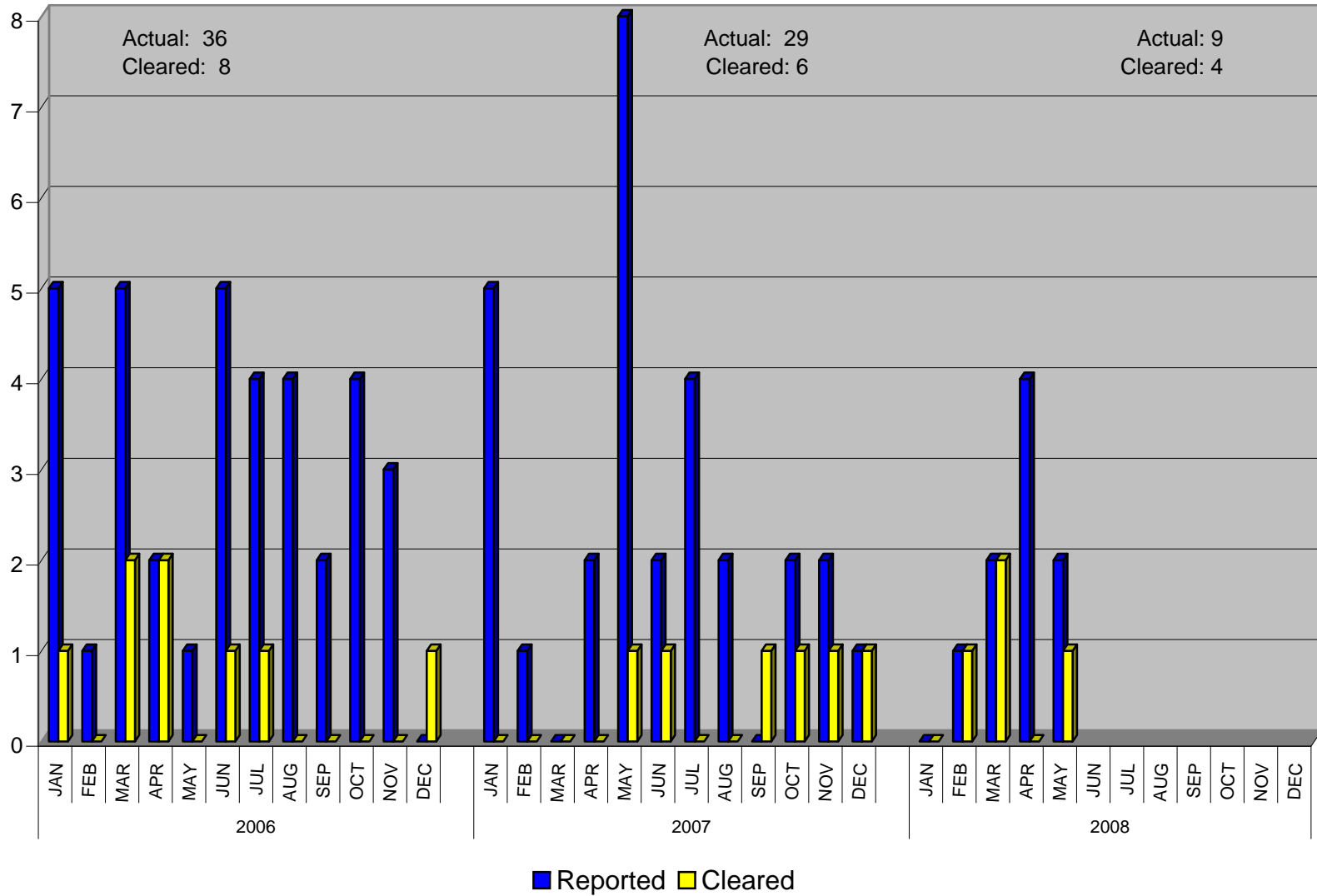

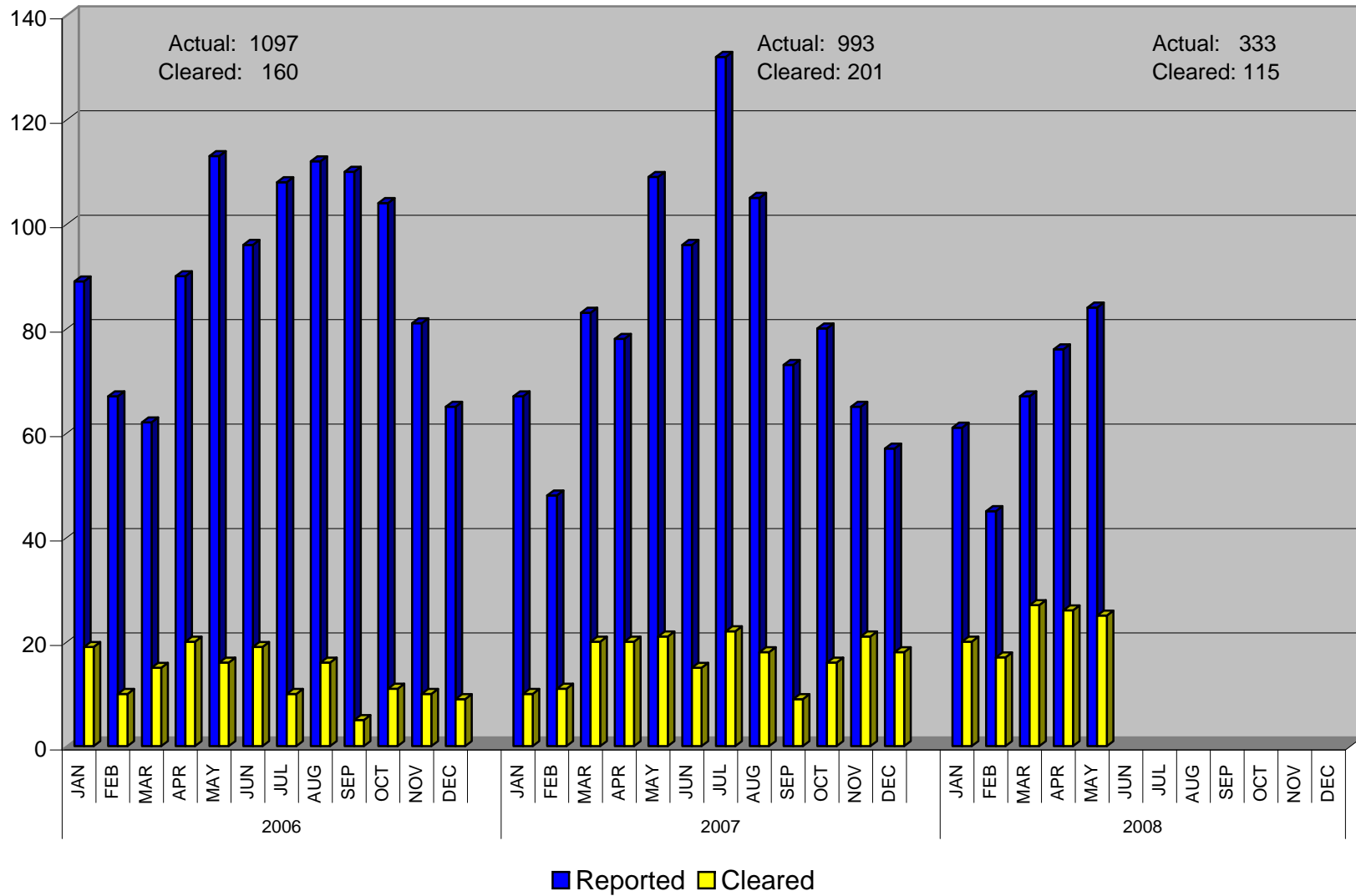
Theft Over

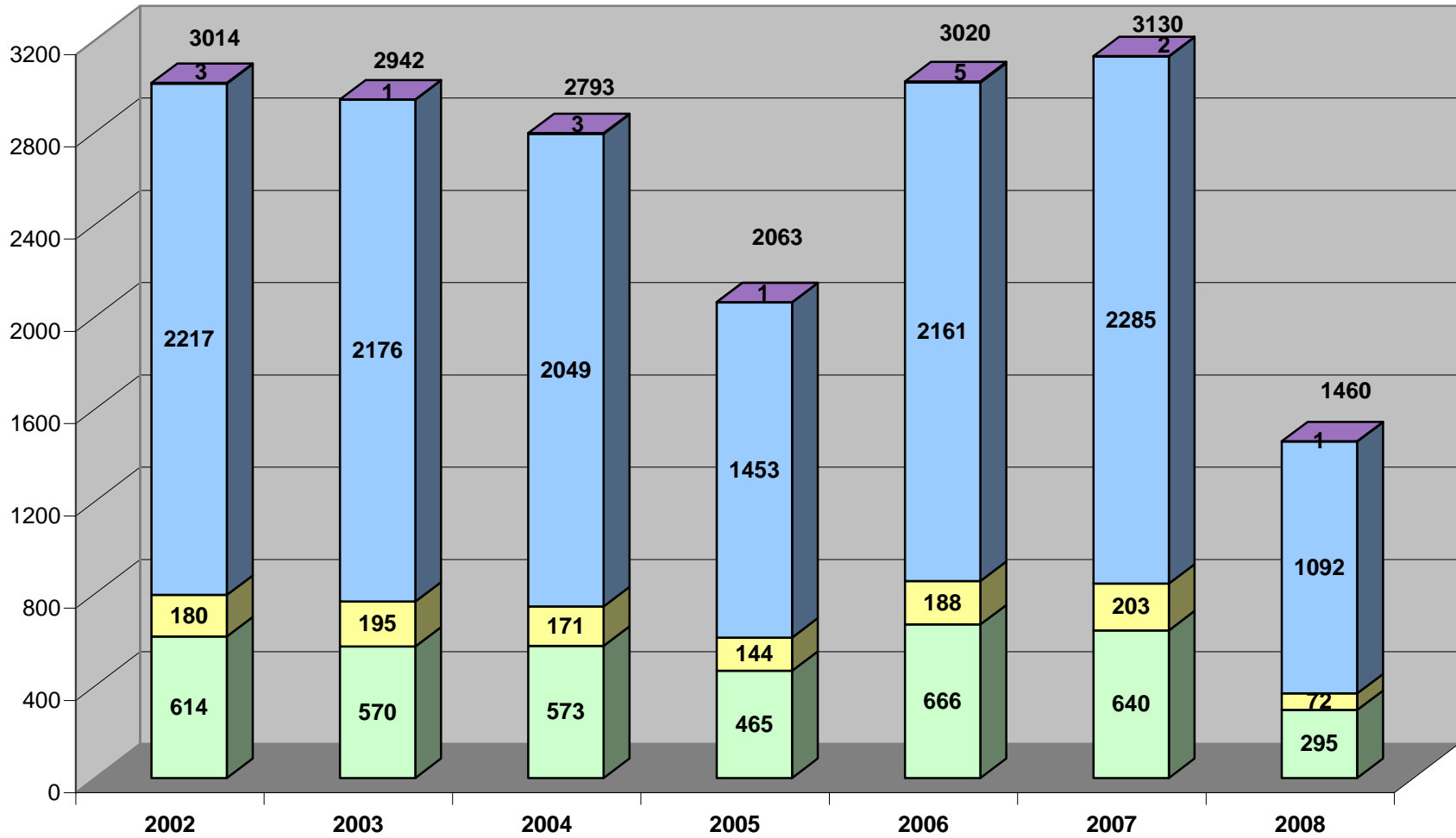


Theft Under

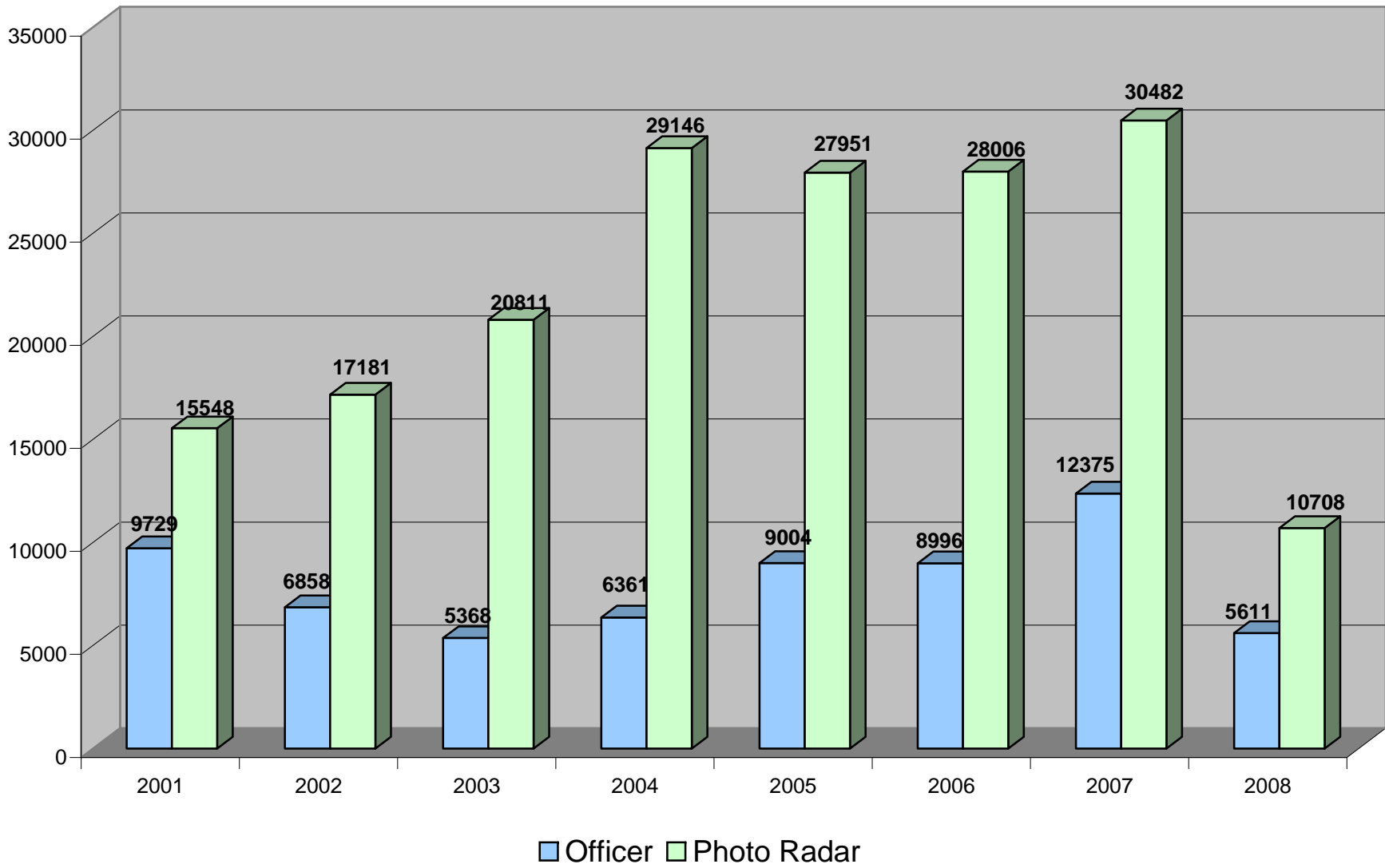


Traffic Accident Stats

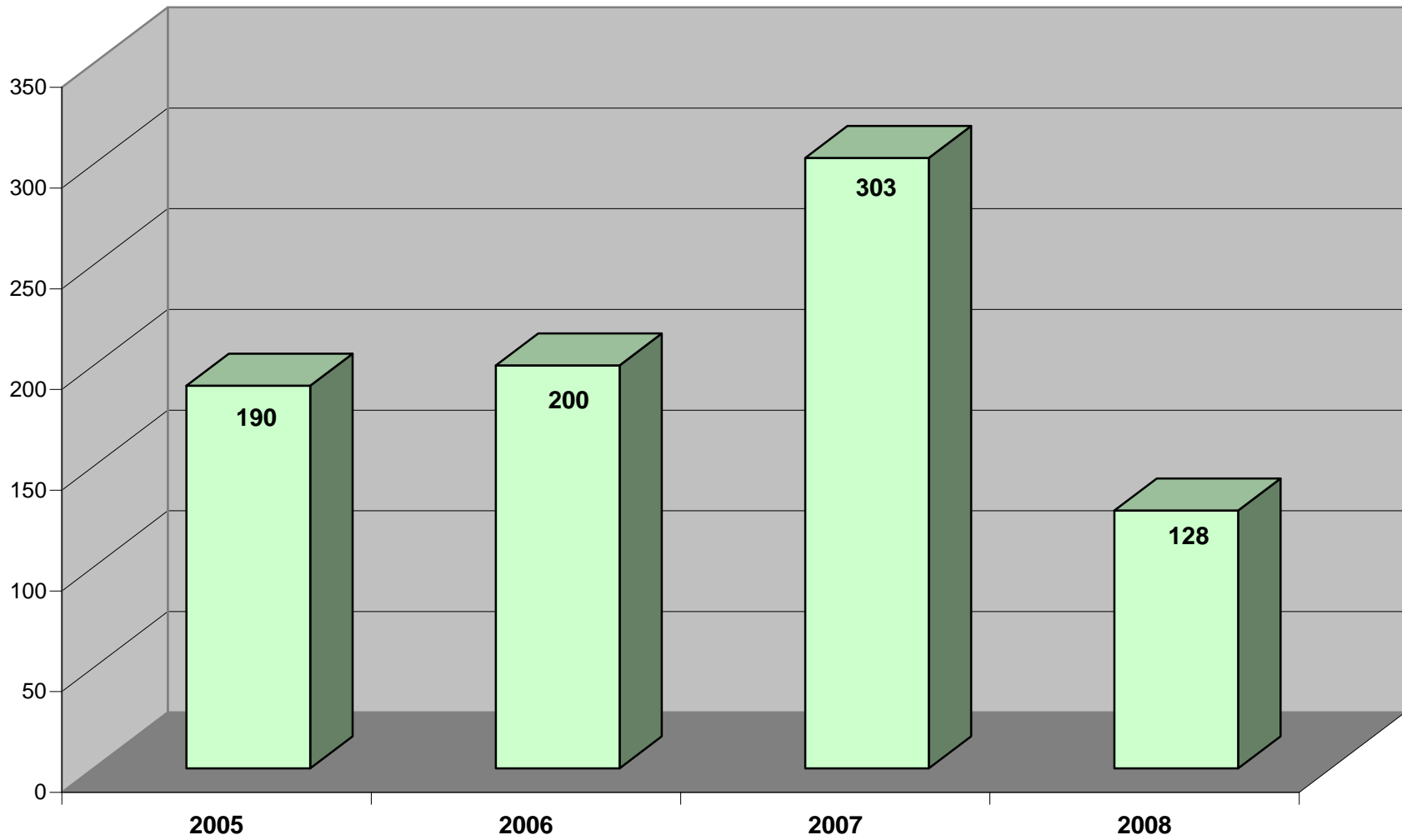


■ Collisions - Hit & Run

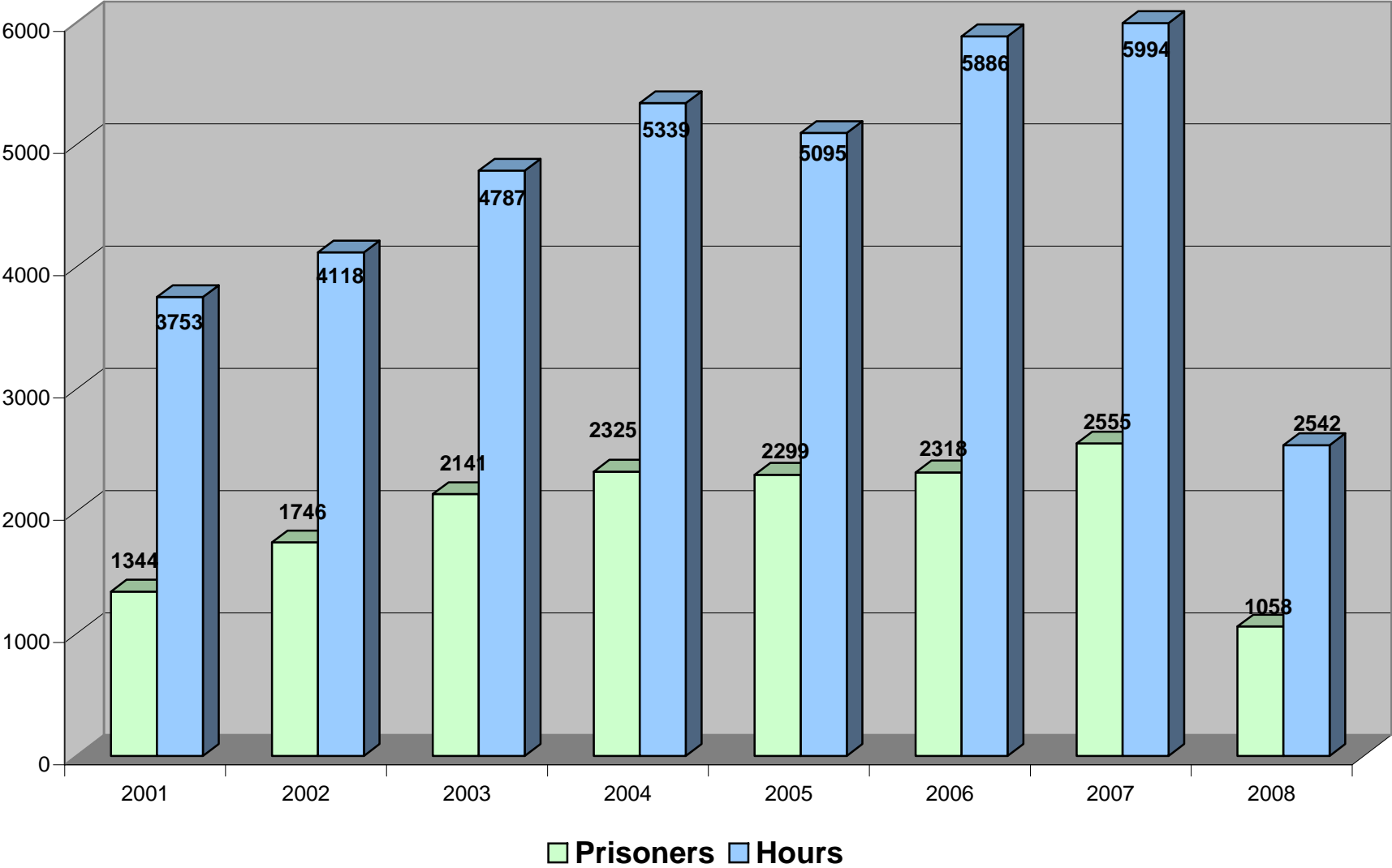
