**A) Trends & Statistics (including Bylaw Enforcement)**

**3. NEW BUSINESS**

**A) Recruitment Status**

Inspector Motz reported on the status of the current recruitment process for police officers. During this process, 78 applications were received and 50 passed the initial screening process, 37 were successful in passing the Provincial Standards testing and were scheduled for interviews. It is anticipated that by March 27, 16 to 20 potential candidates will be selected for consideration by the Executive Team. The next CACJ Recruit class is scheduled to begin in May.

**B) Performance and Development Process**

Inspector Wagle reported on the Performance and Development process, which utilizes the Versaterm records management system to manage employee career development planners. Coaching initiative is utilized to encourage constructive communication between staff at all levels of the organization.
